From the Coronet

Greetings unto the Populace of An Dubhaigeainn

The trek to and from Pennsic was uneventful for most of the populace that made the trip. We all eventually made it home safe and sound, some with minor scrapes and bruises. The time at the great pilgrimage was very eventful indeed. We had many great allies including Aethelmearc, Atlantia, Drachenwald; which allowed the East to take a great many war points!

Their Majesties were generous to members of our populace. Juliana le Chaluner is now a Lady of the Court, Dante now a Lord of the Court, and Kiera and Logan were inducted into the Order of the Tygers Cub.

Radames of Surtr's Brood followed his house brother, Lord Juan Paco, to win the novice tournament. His final match pitted him against Tycho Mikkelson, another member of our populace.

Extra special thanks to Master Jena Xavier Boullier, Lady Sorcha of Stonegrave, Lord Ronan, Lady Katarina de la Mer, Kevin of Dogwood, Baroness Gianetta who helped out throughout the day with set-up, takedown and anything else that needed to be done.

We would be remiss not to thank Lord Thorolf Egilsen, for allowing us to totally take over the camp for the day, and for building the most amazing fire pit and spit, for which part of the meal was roasted.

While at the war we were presented a correspondence from one of An Dubhaigeainn's long lost sons, Lord Lucus von Aych (see copy of letter on page 8) thanking many for their input into his life that made him the man he is today – a man that is soon to be inducted into the Order of the Chivalry in the Kingdom of Lochac.
