Medieval News From Around The Globe

Archaeologists have discovered the site (New Place-Stratford-on-Avon) where Shakespeare lived until his death. The home was demolished in the 18th century. New Place was built in 1483, and Shakespeare purchased it in 1597. Remains of two houses were found on the site; the older excavation revealed a brew house and kitchens. There will be a planned exhibition in 2016 centered around the 400th anniversary of his birth.

-900 Year Old Crypt Protected By "Magic" Discovered in the Nile Valley Link:<u>www.dailymail.co.uk/sciencetech/article-2527014/</u>

A 900 year old crypt covered floor-to-ceiling in magical inscriptions has been discovered in the Sudan containing 7 naturally mummified bodies, including the body of Archbishop Georgios from the Makuna Kingdom (750-1150). They were excavated in a monastery at Old Dongolal, which was the capital of a lost medieval kingdom in the Nile Valley. The inscriptions were written in black ink on whitewash in Greek-Sahidic Coptic. Excerpts from The Gospels of Luke, John, and Matthew along with magical names and signs were found on the walls. Researchers believe the inscriptions served as protection of the deceased against evil.

-2400 Year Old Baby Bottle Shaped Like A Pig Found link:<u>www.dailymail.co.uk/sciencetech/article-2526953</u>

Found by Italian archaeologists, the bottle contained terracotta balls and doubled as a rattle. It was believed to have belonged to a member of the Messapian tribe of southern Italy.30 objects were found, including w female figurines, 3 more baby bottles, jars,vases,laps,and plates, which have been restored.
