Directions:

Long Island Estonian House is located 65 miles east of NYC in Middle Island, New York, north of NY Route 25.

From the West: Take your best route to the Long Island Expwy (I-495) east, to Exit 64 North (NY-112) towards Port Jefferson. Drive for 3.2 miles, then turn right onto Middle Country Rd. (NY Rt. 25) for .03 miles and jog left onto Mt. Sinai Coram Rd. for 2.2 miles. Turn right onto Whiskey Rd. for 1 mile. Then turn right onto Middle Island Blvd. The entrance to Estonian House will be on your right.

From the East: Take the Long Island Expwy. to Exit 68 North (William Floyd Pkwy.--CR 46) to Middle Country Rd. (NY Rt. 25). Turn left and travel on NY Rt. 25 for 4.7 miles. Turn right onto Church Lane, then take your third right onto Lake Terrace. Turn left onto Middle Island Blvd. The entrance to Estonian House will be on your left.

Fencing Tourney

Save my Sheep!

This tourney shall take place in the rocky crags outside the Clan MacEanraig tavern, the Bloody Kneecap. The format will be a round robin for the first three parts, then by invitation only to defend the sheep. Keep in mind that the Marshal in Charge is challenged in accounting and can be bribed to assure a fencer has a score of 1 pt if needed...

The tourney will start with all fencers facing off against each other in a round robin, 3 to 5 bouts each, depending upon the size of the field of fencers. The field will be on a slope with some obstructions and perhaps trees, so terrain will play a bigger part than in usual tourneys. The first round of fights will be with single sword only, the second round shall be with sword and targe (a buckler of EK regulation size limits to 24" round or less), the third round shall be with sword and shillelag (stick or cane) with the last series using a plushie sheep and single sword. Default weapon options if the fencers are not qualified will be single sword. Total scores will be tallied as follows: first blood in the best of 3-5 series gets 2 pts(this is awarded only once per pair of combatants), killing an opponent 1 pt, and a double kill will count as -1pt for both fencers. Each fencer will be scored in each series of bouts, and only those fencers with a positive score may proceed to defend my sheep.

For the last part, in defense of the sheep, a sheep may be carried or placed on the ground (in the case of fencers not qualified in soft parry they must place the sheep on the ground 10ft. from any edge of the list field OR carried behind their person with the off hand). Once placed on the ground, sheep CANNOT move nor be picked up again. Sheep are not to be abused, kicked, verbally molested or mistreated when on the ground! If an opponent stabs a loose sheep with their sword, it is considered dead and the sheep's defender loses the bout. Sheep that are stepped on or kicked by any fencer will run away, and the defender of said sheep loses. Sheep CAN be used as a soft parry and will not die if used as such. (these are MY weird sheep...) This part of the tourney is a round robin single elimination, courtesy and chivalry to be shown to an opponent who loses an arm or leg. A double kill is a double kill, no do overs.

There are prizes for each of the top placements in the four aspects of this tourney, let's see who can save my sheep the best!
