Hear Ye! Hear Ye!

In the SCA you can use any name and device you want. But if you want to register a name or device it has to follow certain rules, and be one significant difference, or two smaller changes away from any other name/device that's already registered. So why bother to register?

If you want to be John Smith, you can be John Smith. But if you don't register, and somebody else submits that they want to be John Smith, then they get claims first. If the guy is a jerk and gets a bad reputation, then you introduce yourself as John Smith to somebody new at an event they might think you're the other John Smith and immediately judge you. Or if you want to have a red shield with a white lion on it, but somebody else from the Midrealm already registered that device then when you get into battle at Pennsic, they see the shield before they see the blue tape on your helm and they'll smack you down hard.

Or, as just happened this past December, there was a lady called up in court to be given her Award of Arms, but two ladies with the same name went up! The King was quite embarrassed as they had to figure out which lady the award was meant for. (It did get sorted out, and the other lady received a token from His Majesty for her trouble.)

If you don't care that somebody else has the same name or arms as you, or if you have something you love that you know would be rejected then sure, nobody says you have to register it. But to have a name or device that is uniquely yours, and helps to enhance the SCA experience, then I think it's worth the effort!

A&S is scheduled to be a 2-part program this month.

Part I, Friday Jan 22nd 7:00PM

This is the Prep Class.

We will be looking at some basic patterns, taking measurements, and laying out patterns on paper to those measurements.

We will also discuss fabric and color choices, where to obtain fabric and how much you'll need.

We can also discuss how long each item takes to make in the real world (ie, your living room or kitchen) vs how long it's likely to take in a class situation, and work out the schedule for what is being done in the hands-on day.

If you can, please bring a pen or pencil, folder, and tape measure (I'll have several tape measures available)

Part II, Saturday Jan 30, 10am

This is the Hands-on Class

If you have a sewing machine that you can bring, this is Highly Encouraged as it is better to learn on the machine you'll use regularly, and I can tailor instruction as needed.

We expect to begin PROMPTLY at 10AM, by the clock, not "SCAdian time".

For each item being made, we will lay out fabric, cut it, prepare it for sewing, and then sew/construct the garment.

Please plan to be with us the whole day. If you can not, and know in advance, I will try to accommodate requests for what order things are done in.

At some point we will break for lunch and dinner, both of which are potluck, please bring something to share! (preferably not something greasy, you don't want to get oil on your new clothes before you get to wear them!)
