How submit an award recommendation.

With the submission link on the East Kingdom Web page ("Recommend An Award" in the Quick Links box), writing in someone for an award has never been easier. The most important thing is to know what the criteria is for the award you are recommending a gentle for.

Recently the attached grid was published in the East Kingdom Gazette. So knowing about all the East Kingdom's awards is only a glance away.

Before you go to the link, gather some information about the proposed gentle. For instance: Persona Name; why you think they deserve the award; a digital picture (is always helpful), the gentles expected royal progress attendance schedule (not always available), persona info of the gentle. While the 1st 2 items are a necessity the 3rd & 4th as well as other items of information are not required at time of submission. However additional information may be requested at a later date.

The biggest suggestion I can offer is review what an award is given out for, so that you are recommending the person for the appropriate award. Having assisted many reigns with their awards recommendations, thus reading hundreds of recommendation letters, I know how critical this can be.

If you are thinking of writing a gentle in for a High Merit or Peerage, you should really try to determine if the gentle is associated with a peer in anyway (apprentice/cadet/protégé/squire or student); and get their feedback first – or in the very least let the peer know you are writing in their 'dependent'.

Flowery language is not necessary in you reason 'description', but know that your words may be the base of the wording on the potential scroll. When writing in for an order of High Merit or Peerage, know that these are polling orders. Your words will be submitted to the orders, so that the members of the orders may advise the crown. This is where detail information is very helpful.
