Potted Arms and Fancy Faire

The Canton of Hawkes Reache will be holding the annual Fencing Championship of the Barony of An Dubhaigeainn to coincide with the midsummer witch-burning festival of Sankt Hans! While there will be no bonfires, there will be heavy fighting, A&S workshops, a May Pole, a day board, and of course, fencing. The fencing tournament will be run by last year's champion, Lord John Xavier Boullier.

Please contact the autocrat if you have allergies, require a silent herald, or have a special needs child. There will be a Sanctuary of St Dymphna* at this event.

*what is a Sanctuary? It is a "safe zone" for veterans, and others, fighting on the field with PTSD (and any other anxiety disorders). However, a key to this is also privacy, so as Autocrat I ask you be respectful of anyone in there. The space will be marked by a lantern with white lilies in it, and it is both where those who need to retreat from the fray can recharge and where fencers and heavy fighters can pay respects. I do want to stress that bringing your sword to the lantern isn't so much a symbol of praying to St Dymphna, so much as letting any fighter struggling with PTSD know that you're there with them (at a respectful distance).
