The Spring Scola-What Do You Do With A Pirate Ducky?

As a barony we have read with the Russians and studied at the Sourbone. Now we have the opportunity to play with the Pirates! Classes will be selected with an eye towards the skills and crafts needed to run a ship, maritime history, and other assorted “piratical activities.”

Lord Eanraig the Bonesetter created a rousing challenge to inspire our populous to a rousing Bardic Competition.

As your outgoing champion, I look forward to participation by any who would care, and will sponsor 3 neat nautical items, in keeping with the maritime theme.

For those entering: you will be asked to come up with your personal backstory and how it is linked to pirate activity or maritime trade to introduce yourself, and then perform 2 of the following: a poem about the sea or pirate activity (self composed is better), playing a musical instrument to pass the time, a song with a maritime theme, a story or piratical actions, or the impromptu challenge...

There is an exciting A&S Championship competition designed with fun and flair by our outgoing champion- Genevieve Velleman. She has decided that as pirates we need to go in a new direction. So those entering are being given extra points for attempting new crafts. This is a perfect opportunity to try embroidering your device on a bit of sail, baking some ships biscuits, carving a bit of bone or wood, knitting a thrum cap, or showcasing a hidden skill learned in an exotic port.

Class List for Scola

Nautical Knots-

Will cover: common knots used aboard pirate ships, dinghys, rowboats, and important ties and their uses. Splicing rope ends, whipping rope ends will also be covered. How NOT to tie important knots.

Thrown Weapons for beginners-

How to throw your dagger without injuring yourself or your comrades.

Black Powder-

The history of Black Powder in Period

Pirate Legends-

Hear the tales of yore told by a pirate.

The Mary Rose: Anatomy of a Ship Wreck-

The History of the Flag ship to King Henry the VIII and pictures of items recovered.

SCA 101 (30-60 minutes)- Are you new (or new-ish) to the SCA? Trying to figure out how things work, What all those odd terms in an event announcement mean, or what there is to do that you might be interested in? Come to SCA 101 to get the basic information you'll need to have the most fun you can have! This class is likely to be EARLY in the day so please be on time!

BASIC CARE AND USE OF A SEWING MACHINE (1 hour) Basic demonstration of how a sewing machine works, what adjustments are available on it, and how to oil and clean out the fuzzums yourself. Observers are welcome, participation is encouraged - If you bring your sewing machine, I will tailor instruction to individual machines. Those who bring a machine to work on will also have the opportunity to construct a drawstring pouch as a means of learning how your machine works.

REQUIRED materials to participate: sewing machine (and the manual if you have it, especially for "modern" machines), a medium sized safety pin, fabric scissors, thread, extension cord, and a bobbin that fits your machine. If you do not have a bobbin already wound you'll learn how to.

This class is geared for adults, but children under 15 are welcome IF their parents are comfortable providing the child with a sewing machine. 15 and up are considered adults for the purpose of this class.

GARB CONSTRUCTION 101 (90 minutes, can squish to 1 hour if needed): We will cover construction techniques for Basic pants, Tunics, and tunic dresses. There will be discussion of appropriate Fabrics, as well as short-cuts by modifying modern clothes for those who are interested. Time permitting, we'll look at construction of simple skirts and chemises, as well. **DETAILED** Handouts will be provided
