The History of An Dubhaigeainn

Installment 3

AUGUST 1987 - New authorizations: Lorenzo, Vanemonde, Nova, Mark, Saravit, and Leif. PENNSIC WAR XVI (Debatable Lands)

SEPTEMBER 1987- Hoped for Middle Eastern event did not come about.

OCTOBER 1987 - Activities above continue, with the addition of Oct. 10th, Gunther Schwarzwaldsohn received an Award of Arms

BREWERS GUILDMASTER: Eadred Breowan

AS XXII - In the reign of TRX Morgan and Rowan:

NOVEMBER 1987 - Needle workers begin meeting, organized by Gwenlynn and Mairgret. Feast of St. Andrew's cancelled. On the 7th, Azin Court was held in Ostgardr, and on the 13th, a big Commons was held in Bayville at a site with kitchen and dancing accommodations. Several Shire folks went to Puntatalon in Dragonship Haven in the 14th, where Lorenzo made it into the quarter finals.

DECEMBER 1987 - On the 27th, Cynyr and Sine married.

FEBRUARY 1988 - Feb. 13th, we had a very successful Wassail at the Ale House, autocrated by Eadred, who was assisted by his lady wife (Laura) and Michal. In the afternoon, there were tavern-style contests, including some very impressive arm wrestling in which Dragonship Haven's crew proved more than capable. The buffet feast was bountiful, the brewers tested one another's work, and the mood was right for the singing and storytelling which lasted for hours with no voice or cup left unraised. On the 20th, a trip to the Metropolitan Museum of Art was made. In this month Lions End officially became an incipient canton of Ostardr.

SENESCHAL: Leif Tuborgsson

MARCH 1988 - Another trip was made on the 12th, this time to the American Museum of Natural History and the Metropolitan.

APRIL 1988 - On the 16th, Celtic Silliness took place again in Ostgardr; the C. W. Post Ren Faire was held on the 24th in Lions End, at which Gwenlynn of Woodlyn received an Award of Arms.

AS XXII - in the reign of TRM Gavin and Sedalia:

MAY 1988 - All activities healthy, but either drafted into or set aside for the preparations for the 21st, when the Shire was honored to host the Crown Tourney of Their Royal Majesties Gavin and Sedalia. Mairgret was Autocrat, Richard was Kitchen Autocrat, and the "Dessert Specialists" of Lions End gave their best. At Royal Court, Mairgret of Carrigart, Muirdeach of Carrigart, and Lorenzo Quintain were granted Awards of Arms. (The tournament was subsequently declared invalid by the Steward of the Society, because of a lapse in membership of the victor, Lord Lucan. We still "awarded him the tourney prize, however, of a genuine box of Wheaties with his picture reproduced on it--which first got lost in shipping, and then couldn't find him--we'll track him down with it when he least expects it, though. . . Crown was ref ought on July 3rd.) May 22nd, Gunther and Gwenlynn married; Barbara and Ousa Stefan were also married on the 15th in Mountain Freehold.

JUNE 1988 - On the 11th, Islip Americana Faire demo was given, for which locals and Lions turned out (side by side with a Revolutionary War recreation group--clouds of musket smoke drifted through the lists!); Mairgret and Gwenlynn gave an embroidery demo. At the King and Queen's Champion Tourney & Curia Regis in Rusted Woodlands on the 18th and

19th, our folk presented the Kingdom's share of the Crown Tourney profit, in the form of a chest full of silver tygers.

JULY 1988 - Archery up again. Shire Commons/barbecue/photo session

AUGUST 1988 - PENNSIC WAR XVII: Once more we strode into the Debatable Lands in the service of our Kingdom, and yet the Midrealm won (5 to 3) in spite of all An Dubhaigeainn's efforts. The East took the Belted Champions tourney, the Woods Battle, and the Speed Round in archery. Twelve of our folk camped with Settmour Swamp, some volunteering as part of the Pennsic Security Force, while others formed the Crown Guard for Their Royal Majesties, serving on the field and in the Royal encampment. Our Katie of Carrigart earned honors in both Pages School and archery competition. Cattle raiding became a new institution, and was especially popular with the children; our Jersey Duck, made by Gwenlynn, was brought home safe and sound. And on Sunday night, our gentles wandered through encampments with Li011s End folk, singing (and, yes - disporting themselves with laser tag guns).

SEPTEMBER 1988 - On the 24th, there was a journey to the Cloisters made by seven of our folk and five Lions, who caution all to "beware the bookstore! "

HOSPITALIER: Vanemonde

OCTOBER 1988 - On the 15th, Gunther Schwarzwaldsohn received the Queen's Cypher. Diana held a Halloween costume party, for which gentles dressed as people or creatures thought to have existed in faraway lands by folk in the Middle Ages, or as their personas might have dressed for such an occasion. Thus we were transformed: Diana into a fierce Persian de1non, Philip into a somber monk, Leif into a Norwegian troll, Sine into a Banshee, Cynyr into antlered Celtic Cernunnos, Tarin/Dan into the Grim Reaper, Rosamonde into the Lady of the Lake (complete with sword), Geoffrey into David (complete with harp), and Gliobach into a sinister Lady in Green.

AS XXIII - In the reign of TRM Randal and Katherine

NOVEMBER 1988 - On the 17th, eleven of us attended a Renaissance concert by Calliope at Brookhaven Labs, and enjoyed the evening immensely; the players had a wide compliment of shawms, sacltbutts, recorders and krummhorns, as well as a vielle, pipe-and-tambour, and a hurdy-gurdy, all of which they discussed and demonstrated individually between numbers. On the 19th, Leif held his first annual Leaf Harvest, and fed the participants well as reward. The puns were uniformly atrocious that day, and rumors of war and lutefisk abounded. On this day also, this same Leif Tuborgsson was given an Award of Arms in absentia.

CHRONICLER: Fionnghuala Gliobach Mael Ailbe

DECEMBER 1988 - A new choral group, "Cantillation," and dance band, "Pandemonium," were formed and practicing. On the 10th, the incipient canton of Lions End held its first event, Lions in Winter, at which Muirdeach was taken as squire by Duke Sir Gavin Kilkenny, Lorenzo won the gaming tournament, and Cantillation won a bottle of wine in a basket for best Best Period Carol and Best Filk Carol <written by Mairgret of Carrigart), while Diana, as runner-up, was awarded a basket and a "tuna" to carry in it, and Maryette gained an Honorable Mention in the Norman garb competition for her beadwork detailing. Als among the entertainment of the day; the Lions' own rendition of "the Clementine Carols" and the band of folk who entertain throughout the day with their "hand" puppet skits and jokes.

PANDEMONIUM is: Philip of Stryer, Diana Brythonwen, Lorena, Rosamonde de Tournai, and Geoffrey Chamberlain.

CANTILLATION (more or less) is: Rosamonde, Geoffrey, Diana, Leif Tuborgsson, John of Graves End, Miranda Flemkeeper, Sine Fuar Ortagen, Vanemonde, Gliobach and Lorena
JANUARY 1989 - On going fighting and music practices. Our February Tavernevent was cancelled. At Kingdom 12th Night in Lions End on the 21st, Maryette Rianna Cantrell was given an Award of Arms, and Cantillation and Pandemonium both performed to the pleasure of those assembled.
