Member Highlight

Name: Kerry Skadl

SCA name: The name I use is Lady Fiona the Volatile. Fiona is not documentable prior to the 18th century though. So the name I registered is Fionnghuala the Volatile.

How did you learn about the SCA? I earned my undergraduate degree at Stony Brook University. While I was there, there was a club called The Medieval Guild that was loosely affiliated with the SCA. I also met many members of the barony at I-Con where they used to do demos.

What about it attracted you? I always loved renaissance faires. The SCA took it to the next level. I also just liked dressing up in funny clothes and getting drunk with my friends. (I was a college student after all)

How long have you been part of the SCA? I have been active in the SCA since the early 90s.

What is your SCA persona? 14th Century Scotland.

What activities do you participate in? I do a lot of stuff. I really enjoy arts and sciences. I am a brewer, I mostly make mead, although I have made ciders and cordials as well. I am apprenticed to Master Ateno for brewing, and I am active in the East Kingdom Brewers Guild. I do some scribal work, mostly illumination, and have created award scrolls for several baronial champions. I also participate in archery. I am a warranted youth officer, and I often run youth classes and activities at events. I have run the East Kingdom day at youth point at Pennsic with my sister Heugoline for the last 7 years, and have taught teen and tween classes at Pennsic. Heugoline and I also run heavy list fighter support for the East Kingdom at Pennsic. You can find us in the battle-field pavilion during heavy list battles, serving pickles, pretzels, oranges and Gatorade, and keeping the water eaters supplied with water and Gatorade. I currently have the honor of serving as Seneschal of Hawkes Reache.

What has been your favorite event? My favorite event is Pennsic. I look forward to it all year. It's completely immersive. I love spending the week with my household, watching battles, taking classes, and just sitting around the fire. I love drifting off to sleep to the sound of drums playing in the distance. I love to walk through the merchant area at night, when everything is lit by torchlight, and you can almost believe you are in a medieval village. Pennsic is just a magical experience.

What would you say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far? I have two Silver Feathers and dozens of Bronze Ducks. I have an Award of Arms, and I am a member of the Order of the Silver Crescent. I am currently the baronial brewing champion. I also have a Skulldrudgery award. That is an award given in House Three Skulls for showing something other than apathy. We believe in setting the bar high.

What future goals do you have in the SCA? I would like to improve as a brewer and move up the ranks in the East Kingdom Brewers Guild. I also want to improve my illumination and calligraphy skills.
