#### How long have you been part of the SCA?


Approximately five years

OCTOBER 1996

**NOVEMBER 1996** 

On 11/16 Wulstun of Ravenswood auto-crated "St Andrew & St James Share A Quest" at St Peter's in Bay Shore. The feast was cooked by Xaviar Fidelis. A profitable auction was coordinated by Mistress Isabella of York, with donations by herself, Countess Brekke, Sir Richard Blackmoor, Sir Muirdeach, Master Richard the Poor, Duchess Sedalia, Baroness Mairgret, Baron Sean de Londres, Baron Stephan the Salacious, Lady Bree, Lady Annor, Lady Elanore, Bartholomew of Suffolk, Blue Dragon Enterprises and Sunspark Treasures... So many people helped in the smooth running of this event from set-up to clean-up. (A full list in the December VIADUCT)
