Member Highlight

Name: Lady Monkey Makgee (mka Marcy Rogers)

How did you learn about the SCA?

I learned about the SCA around 1999. I never had the opportunity to go though it appealed to me. I agreed to go to my first Pennsic (and my first SCA event ever) in the Summer of 2005 where I camped with my boyfriend's (now my husband - Lord Hrothgar of An Dubhaig-ainn) household: House Three Skulls. Little did I know back then, that more than a decade later, the people I met at my first Pennsic are now my closest friends and my chosen family.

What about it attracted you?

Though my values have changed over the years as I have grown within the SCA, If I were to be 100% honest about what first attracted me to the SCA, it was the dressing up aspect and the parties, the week long camp out with friends and wanting to experience all the stories that my friends have told me about Pennsic.

How long have you been a part of the SCA?

I have been part of the SCA for 14 years, however I would only consider myself more actively involved in the SCA for about the last 6 or so years. I have served the Barony as the previous Mistress of Arts and Sciences . In October of 2017 I became Apprentice and Protégé to Baroness Mistress Suzanne Nueber de Londres. She has been my sounding board, my voice of reason and my greatest support as I continue to grow within the SCA.

What is your SCA persona ?

I fancy myself a 16th Century British/Scottish Baker: providing the daily sustenance to the community. A baker is fully integrated in the community as everyone needs bread. They get to hear stories from all walks of life from their customers that come in on a daily basis. In order to run a successful business, they must be able to stay neutral / non-partisan and fair. Bakers must be true experts in the chemistry that makes the best goods and dedicated to their craft.

What activities do you participate in?

I have dabbled in many different activities in the SCA - Martial as well and A&S. I have both autocratted and feastocratted events. Most people in the SCA in our outside our area know me for my work within the kitchen. Researching and re-creating pre-17th Century feasts is where my major focus has been for most of my active participation within the SCA. I love running a kitchen as well as supporting others run a kitchen.

What has been your favorite event?

My absolute favorite event was the Known World A&S Symposium (KWASS) in 2018. It was a mix of socializing with people I do not get to see often in the SCA, meeting new folks and networking as well as attending classes that kept me engaged and were relevant to my interests. I got to hear about how people outside the East Kingdom approached feasts, I got to see PhD level research from fellow EK populace on food. I left that event newly motivated and excited to be part of such an amazing group.

What has been your favorite moment?

In November of 2017, I feastocratted my first Royal Progress for the Investiture of Baron Titus and Baroness Sorcha. Ionnes and Honig where King and Queen at the time. There were many aspects of that event that I will hold dear, however, my favorite moment of the day though, was when someone ran into the kitchen and yelled "Monkey you are needed in court" ... I was wearing my "not so great" kitchen garb that was spotted with flour and other ingredients and was embarrassed to walk into court that way..... I was presented with a Silver Wheel. One of my closest friends, Lady Violet Hughes read my scroll and since this was my first award, I also received Arms on that day. Ionnes stood up and sang "She's a Lady" as he announced my arms. I still laugh when I think of that moment.

What would say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far?

On a Kingdom level, I have both a Silver Wheel for Service and a Silver Brooch for A&S. In addition to those awards, I have several Baronial award: Many Bronze Duck(s), a Silver Feather for exceptional service within the Barony and was most recently awarded the Roasted Duck award for skill and documented research for feasts.
