Unofficial Court Report: St. Andrew's

September 28, A.S. LI

A beautiful day dawned bright and clear, just after the Autumnal Equinox, and our Fearless Leaders; Prefect Titus Aurelius Magnus and Baroness Sorcha of Stonegrave, were welcomed into the Royal Court of Ozurr the Boot Giver and Fortune Sancte Keyne. It was the Baronial Anniversary, Their Royal Majesties' last Event Prior to their stepping down, and we Ducks were ready to have some fun and see Them off in Style!!

Their Majesties allowed us to hold a Short Morning Court in which our New Seneschal Lord Feargus Mac Cailin offered his fealty to the Coronet in the Name of the Crown. Their Excellencies then announced the day's agenda which included the annual Baronial Championship of Arms - a tourney run by this past year's Champion Lord Antonio Giancarlo Nicastrì; a children's Duck Hunt - run by Lady Caoilfhionn inghean Ceallachain, a "photo booth" in front of a hand painted backdrop created by Lady Oda Lally - elegantly capturing the famous "Sound of Music" scene in which Fraulein Maria spins joyously in a Valley of the Alpine Mountains, enjoying the natural exuberance of youth and beauty; and a few other activities which would be announced during Their Majesties' Morning Court. After these brief comments, the Morning Court was closed.

Once the day's activities concluded, Their Excellencies were once again invited into Their Royal Majesties' Court to Complete their business of the day.

Lord Antonio was summoned into the Baronial Presence to declare the winner of the Baronial Championship Tournament. The tourney was deemed to have been enjoyable and well fought, and Andromedas of Surtr's Brood was called up to replace Lord Antonio in the position of honor behind the Baronial Thrones. Andromedas was also presented with a Scroll Commemorating his Accomplishment created by Lady Fionnghuala the Volatile and Lady Violet Hughes. After Divesting himself of the Champion's Regalia, Lord Antonio was not allowed to leave the Presence as quickly as he might have. In addition to receiving the Outgoing Champion's Token of a Small Glass Duck Pendant, Lord Antonio was also Inducted into the Baronial Order of the Drake's Spur, awarded to those individuals of the Baronial populace who show skill and dedication to one or more of the martial arts within Society.

Titus and Sorcha then requested the presence of five members of the Local Populace who have shown exceptional service to the Barony. They were each presented with a Silver Feather and profusely thanked for their efforts. This was accepted with much laughter and well-deserved applause.

Those awarded were asked to stand and be recognized, to allow the populace to cheer their contributions.

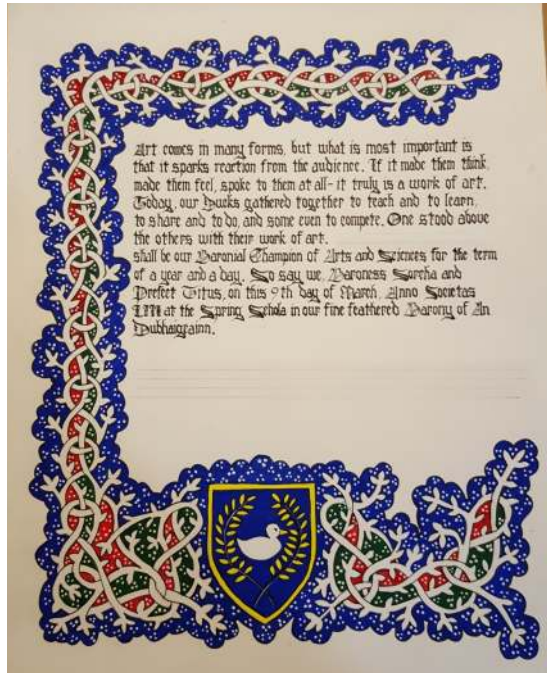

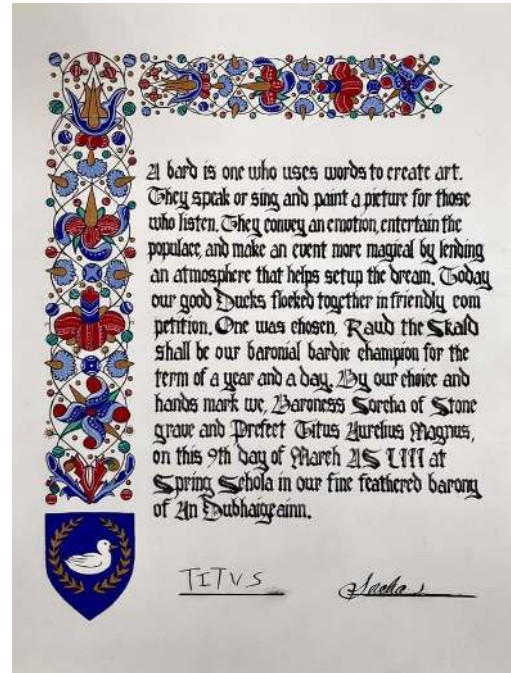

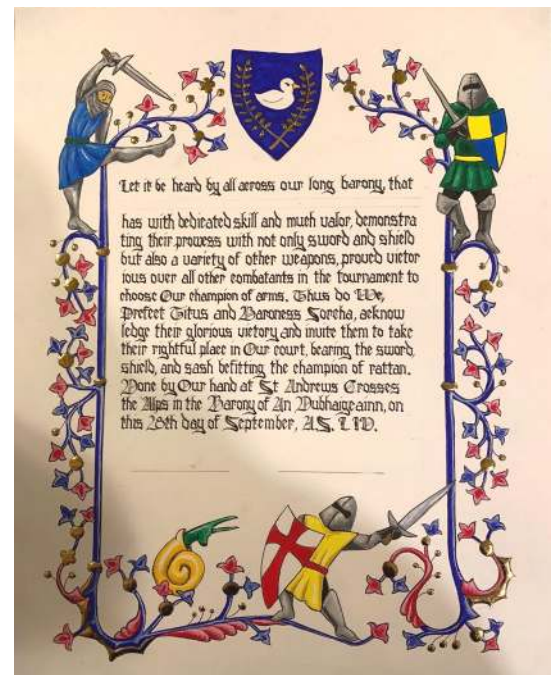

Member Highlight

Name: Titus Aurelius Magnus mka Kevin Dowd

How did you learn about the SCA?

There was a store called Medieval Mayhem that was near my high school. I went there a lot and eventually started working there along side Adeth Macgregor who nominated me as a member of House Three Skulls.

What about it attracted you?

I have always been interested in history and wanted to do more than just read about it. But the thing that attracted me most was that there was a whole world that I never knew existed. Without the SCA I never would have known that i was in a Kingdom and had a King.

How long have you been a part of the SCA?

15 ish years, my first event was Pennsic 33 in 2004. I spent the war in a leaky nylon pop up, spent all my money on armor and rattan and had to do ice runs to earn spare cash for food.

What is your SCA persona ?

Irish celt born in Uí Fhiachrach Aidhne in 124 CE, joined the Roman Auxiliaries in England and spent the next few decades traveling with the legions. Fun fact, I would have been in the opening battle scene of the cinema classic Gladiator.

What activities do you participate in?

I would say I am primarily an armored fighter and a brewer, but I do also really enjoy fencing and am excited to start doing more things with the East Kingdom Foresters guild.

What has been your favorite event?

Its hard to pick a favorite, I like a lot of different events for different reasons. Pennsic is an obvious answer but its so much its own thing. I like the warcamps where after the fighting there is time in the evening for everyone to spend time around a table or a fire talking. I also love our local events, where we get to spend time with each other.

What has been your favorite moment?

My favorite moments are when I get to see other people have their moments. Watching the emotions on peoples faces during elevations. Watching kids or newcomers have their first look of awe and wonder. Watching King Brennan I hoisting a 4x4 of lumber over his head after a hard fought victory at Pennsic.

APRIL 1999

ICON 4/9-11 went well Ladies Dagrún and Seadeach did a fine job in organizing the different aspects of the demo, with Dagrún dealing with the common & classes and Seadeach orchestrating everything else. A great interest was exhibited from many event attendees, which may be future members for the SCA.

At the Royal Court held at Southern Regional War Practice, the Barony gain three more courtiers - Vivats to Lady Althea, Lord Francesco and Lord Aelftheorn.

MAY 1999

JUNE 2000

Commons - South Haven Park; Baronial Bylaw reviewed East End Canton renamed Sandmork; Bylaw Review Committee have begun their work on revamping the current bylaws. A silver feather was awarded for Lord Urlric Bryars.

JULY 2000

West Hampton Library was executed by Lady Elisheva bat Moshe, Signora Gianetta Alegrette, Lady Angelique de Damprierre, Lord Dana Stewart the Witless, Lord Ori, Lord Alec, Lady Althea de Grimm and Lord Francesco de Grimm, providing excellent content to the Youth program at the Library. The success of this demo has exposed us to two other potential demos next year. One for the Riverhead Public Library and one for the Southampton School District.

Mistress Suzanne Neüber de Londres and Lady Dagrún created a durable sheet wall panel for the East Kingdom's Royal encampment that bears to Barony's arms. It should last quite a few years and represent the Barony well.

Some of our fencers helped out another historical group "Historic Arms" at a recent demo, held at the Tall Ship Fair in Glenn Cove 4th of July Weekend.

A story called "Freydis and the Sewer Troll", written by Uncle Eanraig, appeared in the viaduct.

The Baronial birthday event "St Andrews" found our patron staying home and inviting all to join him for a relaxing and convivial time of good friends, good food and a nice fire. The King and Queen, Andreas and Isabella, graced the barony with their presences. The usual Baronial Champion tournament was held as well and a selection of games a gossip entertained the masses. Lady Mary of Carrigart did a wonderful job of auto-crating the festivities. Gregorio de Sicilia was created a Lord of the court as was Magnus Sverre Haakonson de Londres

JANUARY 2001

The Barony held a commons at the Setauket Neighborhood House in the 27th. Master Richard and Lady Adela helped brush off the rust by teach all gentles to dance. A delicious 'pot-luck' was enjoyed by all.

At EK 12th Night Lord Ateno of Annun Ridge became a Master of the Laurel, Baroness Mairgrett of Carrigart became a member of the Pelican, Gianetta Lucia Allegretta was created a Companion of the Maunche. Lord Jean Xavier Boullier was bestowed a glove denoting the Queens Order of Courtesy

The announcement went out that after 10 years of service, our current Baron and Baroness, Muirdeach & Mairgret, have decided to step down; thus a Baronial election will be held in June to choose the next Baron and Baroness of our fair Barony. The Candidates are: Lord Uther Shieldbreaker & Dame Catriona Maighread nic Dhuib of Moray and Lord Jean Xavier Boullier & Lady Gianetta Lucia Alegrette.
