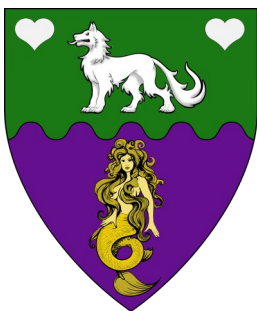

# The History of An Dubhaigeainn

## Installment 22

AUGUST 2005

At Pennsic Royal Court the following were recognized by the crown: George des Bard was inducted into the Order of the Troubador (scroll was created by Lady Kayleigh McWhyte (calligraphy) and his Lady, Avelyn of Mayburgh (beaded illumination and braille). Uther Shieldbreaker was made a Court Baron, Wilhelm der Wannensig received an Award of Arms (as Wilhelm was a member of the Dark Horde Moritu, Temujin Kahn graciously allowed the scroll to be presented to Wilhelm in the Kahns own Court in the names of Their Majesties Kelson and Geneviere. Lara Kveldulfsdatter received an Award of Arms; Sorchea Larasdatter received a Tyger's Cub with an Award of Arms and Pookah Larasdatter also received a Tyger's Cub.

In Pennsic Baronial Court the children of the encampment (Lord Eanraig and Lady Freydis' children, Henry, Matthew, Kirsten, Victoria, and Brendan; and Targei and Aquilina's daughter, Jennifer) were recognized by the coronet with a Baroness's Token and a cookie for the delight they brought to the camp. Ulric was finally presented with his Drake's Spur in recognition for his efforts on last year's great Blackstone Raids journey. Saravit of House Three Skulls was likewise awarded the Drake's Spur for his prowess and dedication to the martial arts within the Barony.
