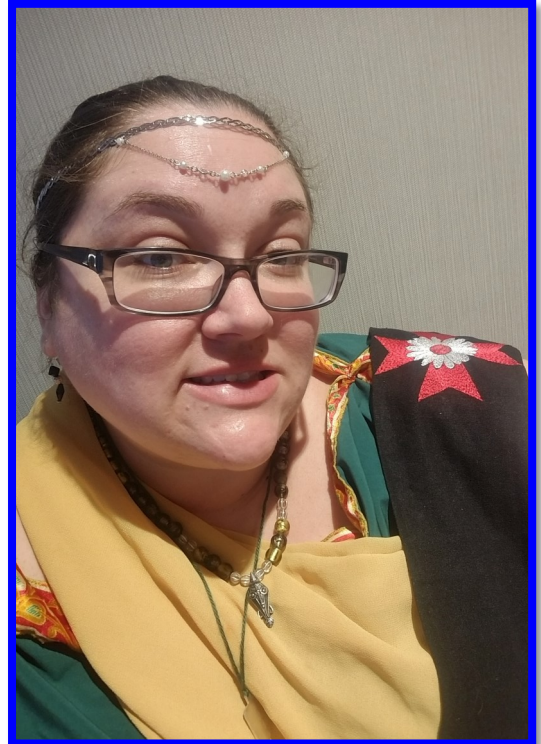
What is your SCA persona? I am still working on my persona, I keep changing my mind on what direction I want to go in.

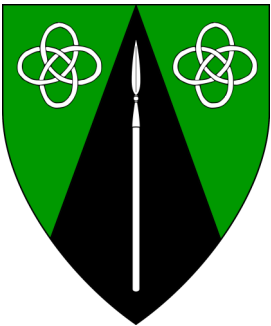

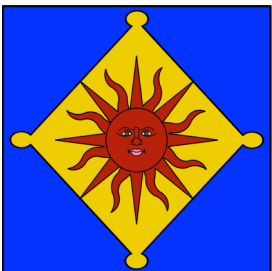
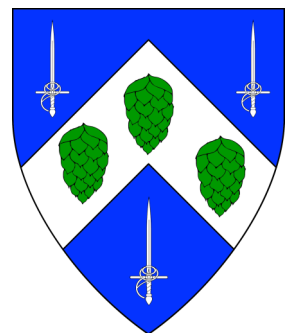

ASXLI: During the Reign of TRM Griffyth and Aikaterine

APRIL 2007

On April 14, at the Last Court of Lucan & Yana, Kay Leigh McWhyte was given a Queen's Honor of Distinction At Balfar's Challenge on 4/21 the Baronial teams went out proving their mettle. First off, the Baronial team was the only one that had teams in all marshal categories and the only one that fielded a three person thrown weapons team. All teams did well and had fun. Of note, Lady Moresca Addams, the An Dubhaigeainn Baronial Fencing champion, with the skills of Lord Alec, lead the fencing team to third place against formidable opponents. A Pennsic Planning Commons was held on 4/15 at the home of Sorcha and Peter's in Northport; 26 gentles attended. Baronessa Gianetta submitted a great article on A&S Documentation to the Viaduct.

JUNE 2007

A Pot Luck Commons was held at the home of Damiana de Londres and Lord Logan de Londres on 6/3 in Middle Island. Archery, fighting and fencing were among some of the activities.

On Jun 23 at King & Queens Archery Champions, Lady Kay Leigh Mac Whyte became Mistress, having been inducted into the Order of the Laurel.

JULY 2007

July 7th brought us a new event called Potted Arms & Fancy Fare, hosted by The Canton of Hawkes Reache (Incipient), auto-crated by Lady Sorcha (and food prepared by Baroness Mistress Suzanne. This event featured a Pas D'Arms tournament to select the new Baronial Fencing Champion. There were games and activities for all! There hearty day board was served throughout the day, and none were left hungry! There were also "Bridge Tournament" & "Hat Auction", a repeat of last year's successful auction benefiting the Baronial Rapier Community where the populace bid for a fencer represented by their hat. If that rapier fighter wins the Bridge Tournament, the bidder wins a prize. Each fencer was required to their own herald to introduce them, with encouragement to actually be an "over the top" herald (like in Knight's Tale), making the show quite hilarious.

AUGUST 2007

The Barony and House Three Skulls spear contingent faced off with the Calontir shield wall during the Bridge battle and made them pay for every foot that they tried to take. We would like to let it be known that Lord Vettorio and Dave Cortijo both fought in the heavy combat and rapier combat battles. A definite test of endurance. Lord Eanraig led a compliment of Baronial archers up to the archery field to elevate the score of the East Kingdom. During the Novice Tourney, Wilf of Surtr's Brood placed second and Lucas of House Griffin's Claw placed well in the standings. At the Known World Baronial Championship, Lord Vladimir did the barony proud with his prowess and knowledge. The annual Runnymede Dinner was hosted by the Barony of Stonemarche, for which, Lord Eanraig offered to serve tea to those in attendance. Many of the Coronets were impressed by his knowledge of all things tea. Congratulations to Lord Thorolf for winning the annual brewing competition at Casa Bardicci. With the guidance of Lord Magnus, Baronessa Gianetta achieved marshal status for Thrown Weapons.
