Directions to 16 Leonard Drive East Northport, NY are as follows:

From the west - take Northern State to Exit 42(Route 231 North) bear right at the fork, follow to Jericho Tpke, head East to next traffic light and make Left onto Elwood Road (Shell Station & Block Buster Video) follow a couple of miles until you cross Pulaski, the Railroad tracks and see Northport High School on your left. At the next light make a right onto Bellerose Avenue - pass the first light (Catherine Street) then make the third left (just past the Salvation Army & LIRR Station) onto Leonard Drive. Go down the hill - we are #16 the fourth house on the right go around the corner to the right and park by the cemetery.

From the east - take the LIE to exit #54, which is the Sagtikos/Sunken Meadow Parkway North. Follow that to Pulaski Road West toward Huntington. Stay on Pulaski until the fourth light and then make a right onto Larkfield Road. Go over the train tracks and bear left at the light onto Laurel Road. Make your 1st left onto Upland Drive. We are the second house on the left. Please park by the cemetery on the right.

Minister of lists- The officer or appointment responsible for: conduction all lists held within the barony.
 Seneschal- The officer or appointment responsible for: conducting all business within the barony not specifically the responsibility of another. The Seneschal is the local chapter president and the official representative of the barony to the mundane world. The seneschal ensures that the actions of the group or its individuals do not violate or contravene; mundane, society, kingdom, or baronial laws and or policies and has the authority and responsibility to enforce compliance. As local chapter president the seneschal is responsible for arranging the agenda of baronial meetings but may not prevent and legitimate business from being discussed.
 4) Add Section II.F.1.e Non required offices remain in effect for the duration of its function, until vacated or for two years from date of creation, which ever comes first.

Policy to be voted on at the St. Andrew's Curia

Baronial Policy Change Proposal 1/6/05
 1) Strike, section II.A. List of Offices, in its entirety and replace it with the phrase The Barony will maintain all offices as required by the kingdom and may adopt other offices as appropriate.
 2) Rephrase and alphabetically merge section II.C. Specific responsibilities, to and with section I.B. Definition of terms as follows:
 Chamberlain- The officer or appointment responsible for: arranging the storage of all baronial property in a reasonable manner making an inventory list of said property available as needed and arranging for baronial property to be available for use as needed.
 Captain of archers- The officer or appointment responsible for: the training and supervision of archers within the barony at sanctioned baronial activities.
 Chancellor of the Exchequer: - The officer or appointment responsible for: the collection distribution and accounting of all Baronial monies.
 Chatelaine- The officer or appointment respon-

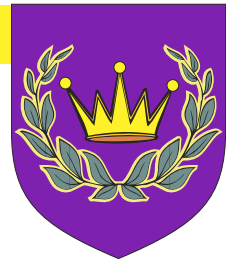
sible for: Collects, maintains, distributes and or loans out resources and or information primarily for the purpose of orienting and welcoming persons new to the barony
 Chronicler- The officer or appointment responsible for: producing and publishing the baronial newsletter on a monthly basis.
 Herald or Pursuivant- The officer or appointment responsible for: all heraldic activities for the barony including the organization and or execution of baronial courts, announcements and cries, and consulting on and registering of names and devices.
 Historian- The officer or appointment responsible for: collecting, maintaining, collating, embellishing, and making available a reasonable history of the barony.
 Knight Marshal- The officer or appointment responsible for: the training and supervision of combatants at sanctioned baronial activities.
 Minister of Arts and sciences- The officer or appointment responsible for: encouraging and organizing activities involving period arts and sciences by providing advice on resources, arranging workshops and direct assistance when appropriate.
