Directions to 16 Leonard Drive East Northport, NY are as follows:

From the west - take Northern State to Exit 42(Route 231 North) bear right at the fork, follow to Jericho Tpke, head East to next traffic light and make Left onto Elwood Road (Shell Station & Block Buster Video) follow a couple of miles until you cross Pulaski, the Railroad tracks and see Northport High School on your left. At the next light make a right onto Bellerose Avenue - pass the first light (Catherine Street) then make the third left (just past the Salvation Army & LIRR Station) onto Leonard Drive. Go down the hill - we are #16 the fourth house on the right go around the corner to the right and park by the cemetery.

From the east - take the LIE to exit #54, which is the Sagtikos/Sunken Meadow Parkway North. Follow that to Pulaski Road West toward Huntington. Stay on Pulaski until the fourth light and then make a right onto Larkfield Road. Go over the train tracks and bear left at the light onto Laurel Road. Make your 1st left onto Upland Drive. We are the second house on the left. Please park by the cemetery on the right.

Site Notes: The site is discreetly damp and no flames are allowed



Greetings All!

We hope everyone had a safe and relatively uneventful trip home from Pennsic. East Kingdom Court at Pennsic recognized the efforts and talents of some of our folks:

George des Bard - Order of the Troubador - The beautiful scroll was created for him by the hands of Lady Kayleigh McWhyte, who did the calligraphy, and his Lady, Avelyn of Mayburgh, who beaded the illumination and braille. Uther Shieldbreaker - Court Baron Wilhelm der Wannensig - Award of Arms - As Wilhelm was a member of the Dark Horde Moritu, Temujin Kahn graciously allowed us to present the scroll to Wilhelm in his own Court in the names of Their Majesties Kelson and Geneviere. We thanked the Great Khan for his warm hospitality. Lara Kveldulfsdatter - Award of Arms Sorchea Larasdatter - Tyger's Cub/Award of Arms Pookah Larasdatter - Tyger's Cub All those who fought under the East Kingdom banner were recognized as one with the Blue Tyger Legion. The East Kingdom army banner will now carry the device of this award.

Our own Baronial Court held at Pennsic saw the recognition of the children within this year's Baronial encampment - Lord Eanraig and Lady Freydis' children, Henry, Matthew, Kirsten, Victoria, and Brendan; and Targei and Aquilina's daughter, Jennifer. Each was presented with a Baronessa's Token and a cookie for the delight they brought to the camp. We hope to see them again next year. Eanreig and Vivian's 2 older sons, Henry and Matthew, were further recognized as the first recipients of the Barony's children's award, the Silver Egg. Like its Kingdom counterpart, the Tyger's Cub, from which it was inspired, the Silver Egg is presented to those children of the Barony who display "admirable virtue and decorum." It was truly a pleasure to have all these children as part of the Baronial encampment.

On a more martial note, Ulric was finally presented with his Drake's Spur in recognition for his efforts on last year's great Blackstone Raids journey. That is the time when they will need us most.

We emphatically request and encourage your participation. Meridies will ever be grateful for your love and support as they so desperately need it. We are a mighty and powerful family and are clear that no disaster, pestilence or tragedy will dampen our resolve to aid many of members at a time when they need it most. We will not desert them.
