Directions to Mary Fernandez 107 East Moriches Blvd., Eastport From the West: Take your best route to Sunrise Highway/ Route 27 and head east to Exit 61 Riverhead/Eastport. Stay straight on the ramp following the signs toward Eastport. The ramp will merge with the South Service Road of Sunrise Highway. You will need to merge to the right lane. At the stop sign turn right onto Eastport Manor Road/ CR-55. At the second traffic light turn right onto Montauk Highway/C-80. Take your first left onto Seatuck Ave. Go over the railroad tracks and then take your first right onto East Moriches Blvd. #107 will be the first house on your right.

From the South Fork: Take your best route to Sunrise Highway and head west to Exit 62/CR-111. The ramp will become the North Service Road of Sunrise Highway. Continue straight at the traffic light, crossing CR-111. Follow the North Service Road to Eastport Manor Road (stop sign). At the stop sign turn left onto Eastport Manor Road/CR-55. At the second traffic light turn right onto Montauk Highway/C-80. Take your first left onto Seatuck Ave. Go over the railroad tracks and then take your first right onto East Moriches Blvd. #107 will be the first house on your right.

From the North Fork: Take your best route to East Moriches- Riverhead Rd/CR-51. Head south to East Moriches. At the second traffic light, turn left onto Eastport Manor Road/ CR-55. At the second traffic light turn right onto Montauk Highway/C-80. Take your first left onto Seatuck Ave. Go over the railroad tracks and then take your first right onto East Moriches Blvd. #107 will be the first house on your right.

From the West: Take your best route to the Sunrise Highway (Route 27) and head east bound to Exit 59 (Wading River Road, Manorville, Center Moriches). Stay on the Service Road until you reach your first traffic light. At the traffic light, turn right onto Wading River Road. Then take your first right off of Wading River Road onto Brookfield Road. Follow Brookfield Road south until you reach a "T" intersection. At this intersection turn right onto Montauk Highway/ Main Street. Proceed west on Montauk Highway/ Main Street under the train trestle to the first light past the trestle. Make a left at this light onto Old Neck Road. About 2 tenths of a mile on your left will be #59.

From the East: Take your best route to the Sunrise Highway (Route 27) and head west bound to Exit 59 (Wading River Road, Manorville, Center Moriches). Stay on the Service Road until you reach your first traffic light. At the traffic light, turn left onto Wading River Road. Then take your second right off of Wading River Road onto Brookfield Road (Note, your first right will be the South Service road of Sunrise Highway). Follow Brookfield Road south until you reach a "T" intersection. At this intersection turn right onto Montauk Highway/ Main Street. Proceed west on Montauk Highway/ Main Street under the train trestle to the first light past the trestle. Make a left at this light onto Old Neck Road. About 2 tenths of a mile on your left will be #59.

Baronial Polling Announcement-

In accordance with AnDubhaigeainn's Baronial policy the Baronial Coronet has announced it will be stepping down in this fall. Therefore the Barony of AnDubhaigeainn will be polling for the succession of its Baronial Coronet.

All persons wishing themselves to be considered as candidates for the Baronial seat must make their intentions known in writing to the Baronial Seneschal, Lord Thorolf Egillsen, no later than April 30, 2006. Prospective candidates are also encouraged to cc to the Baronial Coronet and the Southern Regional Seneschal. Letters of intent should include a brief SCA resume and statement as to why you would like to be considered for the Baronial seat. This information will be included as part of the poll. Said poll, if all goes according to plan, is to

be mailed May 31st and closed June 30th. This polling will be conducted as per East Kingdom Law, VII.C., available on line. Of immediate importance is East Kingdom Law, VII.C.2.; a candidate for any Baronial seat must: be at least eighteen years of age, hold a current Society membership throughout the course of the Baronial seat selection process, reside within the formally approved boundaries of the branch, and not hold any baronial office during the course of their candidacy, except at the discretion of the Crown.
