Baronial Policy Change Proposal 1/6/05 For curia resolution 02/04/06

- 1) Change the definition of commons to read; an activity similar to an event except that it is organized entirely at the local level with out the publishing and reporting requirements of an event.
- 2) Change the definition of event to read; an activity organized, sponsored or hosted by the barony for the purpose of providing a social venue for recreating the Middle Ages. Events by definition are open to all members of the society and as such must meet requirements as set out by the SCA's corporate and kingdom officers.
- 3) Strike the word commons from III.B.2.b

Friday, March 24th thru Sunday, March 26th, 2006

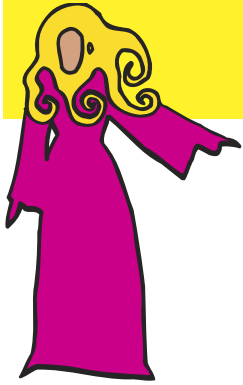

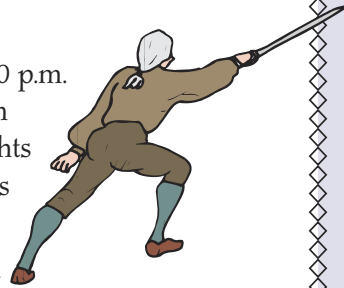
Broadside & Boarding Parties

One of those opportunities in the very near future goes out to the fencers of the Barony, for the Baronial Fencing Champions tourney will be held on February 4th in East Northport. We look forward to seeing the skill of the Baronial populace on the fencing lyst.

Some have come to us and asked what are the duties and responsibilities of a Baronial champion, whether it is in armored combat, fencing, or archery. We hope this will help shed some light on these prestigious positions.

A champion of the Barony will represent the Barony both on and off the lyst field and archery field, thus chivalry and courtesy is expected of the champion at all times. Also, encouraging those around you to aspire in the knowledge and skill of their field of interest and to meet the challenges ahead of them.

A champion will be part of the Baronial entourage and is requested to attend as many Baronial events and activities as possible. We ask that the champions take part in Baronial court as well. Such duties would entail the set up and break down of court and escorting those called into court.

We want to thank Lady Kayleigh McWhyte for inspiring the following champions' quest. We ask that the Baronial champions enter the King & Queen's champion tourneys in their respective martial skill and organize a Balfar's Challenge team composed of 3 pri-

mary participants and one alternate. In addition to this, we ask the armored combat champion to participate in the Baronial Champions Tourney at the Pennsic War.

One of the final responsibilities of a champion is to set forth the challenge(s) for those participants vying to become their successor.

The Barony will be hosting the Runney Meade Dinner at the Pennsic War this year. This dinner is for the Landed Barons and Baronesses of the East Kingdom. It is also an opportunity for the Barony of An Dubhaigeainn to shine and to introduce our successors to the other Barons and Baronesses.
