The staff is doing some medieval theme activities and we are going to attempt to put on a little improvisational show for them so turnout is a must. The setting will be a late period dance or ball so dress as best you can. We will setup at 6:00pm and must be ready no later than 6:30pm. We'll be on for 1 hour or a little less. Plans are to invade a local diner where we can earmark the generous donation that Avalon Gardens has offered us. Avalon gardens is located just north of the Smithtown Bull on the east side of 25A. The Bull is about a mile West of the Smithtown Brushbarn. If you don't know where that is it Take your best route

to the Long Island Expressway (Route I-495) to Exit 56 Route 111 Wheeler Road heading north. At Old Town Road bear right and then left while following the signs for Route 111. Stay on Route 111. After entering the Village of the Branch, you will come to a five way intersection for Route 25 (Main Street), Route 25A and Route 111. Turn left onto Route 25/25A (Main Street). Approximately 1mile west of 111, 25 and 25A will fork at a big bronze bull. Bear right with 25A and Avalon gardens is the first driveway on the right after the fork. Once your on the driveway keep left and park near the entrance at the far end of the parking lot. It's OK to park in empty staff spots as the work day will be over. 
