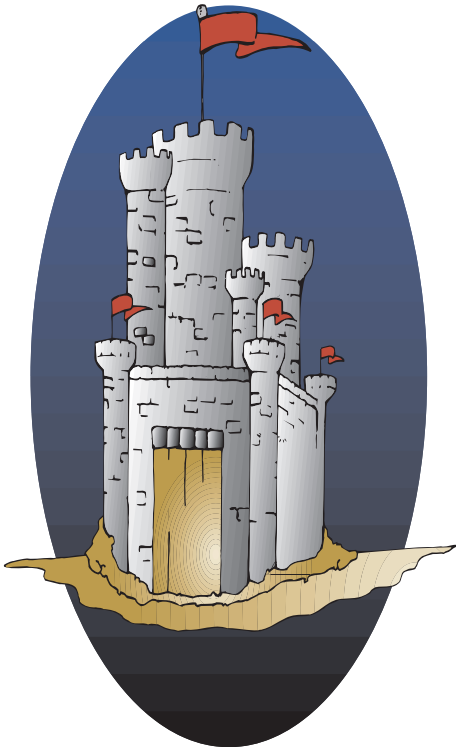

butts off the day of the dinner, those that stood out in the rain to stand guard duty, and those that stayed for clean-up:

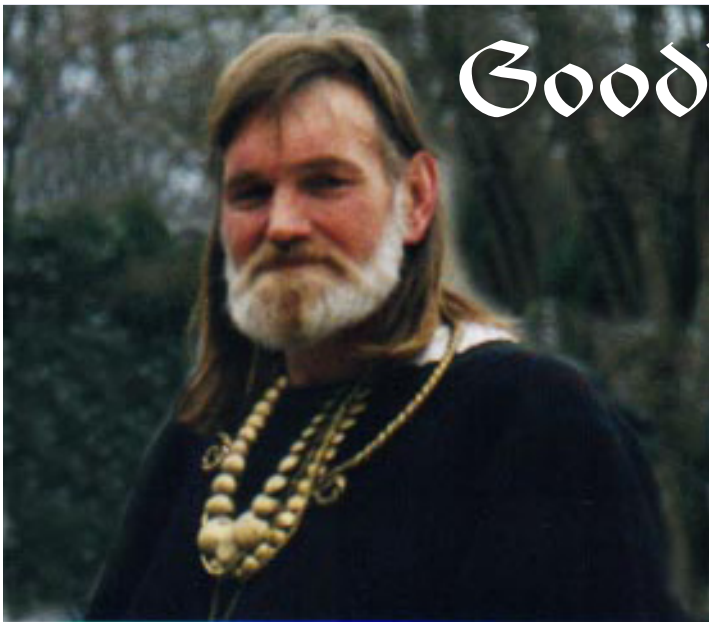
