Baronial Policy Changes

Below is the full text of the changes to Baronial Policy, which were passed at the July 10th Baronial Business Meeting.

1) Definition of a Commons:

"Commons - A social meeting, held for the purpose of fostering the local SCA Community between local events. By custom Commons are normally held in garb and without a fee being collected by the hosting branch."

2) Section II.E.1.d (Baronial Officers->Termination->Term of Office):

- "d. The following officer terms expire at the following meetings but may be reapplied for if the person holding the office is eligible and wishes to continue:
- i. Seneschal, and Knight Marshal: 1st meeting in the first half of odd years, CE.
- ii. Exchequer, Minister of Arts & Sciences: 1st meeting in the second half of odd years CE.
- iii. Chatelaine, Minister of Lists: 1st meeting in the first half of even years CE.
- iv. Herald and Chronicler: 1st meeting in the second half of even years CE."

Below is the full text of the proposed changes to Baronial Policy, to be voted on at the September 4th Baronial Business Meeting.

Proposed Policy Changes:

The current fencing fund is relegated to only paying for the site on which practices are held. As this fund is no longer necessary the Barony is planning on moving these funds to the general Baronial fund.

However the income from our Auctions at "Potted" Arms & Fancy "Faire" will be added to a new general use fencing Fund. These changes will be voted on at the September business meeting. If you have any concern regard this change please contact the financial committee before that meeting, the Baron, Baroness, Exchequer, and Seneschal.

There with also be a Dueling Tournament throughout the day where you can challenge other fencers to duels using as much period style (seconds, insults, challenges, betting, etc.) as you like. Thirdly,

There will be a light day board served throughout the day, and a hearty eve board at night so that all appetites will be appeased. - Continue on Wall Street for 3/4 mile to Southdown Road.

 Make a left onto Southdown road and follow the signs to Browns Road.
- · There will be a stop sign at the corner of Browns Road and Southdown Road.

 Turn right onto Browns Road, the site is on the left shortly after the elementary school.
