People have inquired about a children's Youth Pointe (aka A&S for minors). I was surprised how many people did not know there are rules and now a background check .This is do to all the real world issues that we face today. Below is the information I have located. If any two are willing please contacts me.

All the information I have found is on the www.SCA.org site.

First and Newest is as of December 26, 2007 All youth activities officers must have a background check done, to be implemented on February 15, 2008. The Seneschal will have the information about this.

This article is under what's new news.

This next information comes from an October 24th, 2007 T.I. article. It is one that is also on the www. SCA.org. T.I. has been posting some of there articles on the web there. Please look it up as I am stating only the most important of points.

There must be two people to run the Youth Pointe. They must be at or above legal adult age for that state, unrelated to one another by blood, marriage or relationship.

There is paperwork mentioned that must be looked into once the Barony has volunteers for this. It is a very good article to read on the subject!!

Seneschal Handbook (this too is available at www.SCA.org. Once again, I am only writing what I feel is the most important. Please see these rules for the full information.)

VIII Children's Activities A

For all organized SCA functions for minors, a minimum of two adults (at or above legal majority in the state, province, or country in which the activity occurs), unrelated to one another by blood, marriage, or relationship must be present. This policy does not relieve parents or guardians from their primary responsibility for the welfare of their children. This policy is not subject to granting of variance or grand fathering of existing activities.

XII Parental Responsibilities for Children at SCA Events.

I am only writing parts that I feel I need to. Please, once again, read the whole article at www.SCA.org in the Seneschal Handbook.

i. Children below the age of 5 should not be left unsupervised by the parent/legal guardian at SCA functions, even at planned children's activities.

iii. Children 12 years old and younger are not considered suitable baby-sitters for younger children.
