Event summaries St.Andrews in a Foreign Port

On the first day of November, Anno Societatis XLIII in the Barony of An Dubhaigeainn, a tournament was held. Lord Titus' year of dedicated service as Baronial Champion for their Excellencies

Baron Ateno of Annun Ridge & Baroness Lassar Ingen Aeda, having come to an end, a successor was needed.

Both men fought hard and admirably. Eventually Hilarivs was defeated by Marcus, who was declared the day's victor.

In court Their Excellencies accepted Marcus as their champion and Lord Titus passed on the regalia of the office, having served the Barony well during his tenure. In addition Marcus was presented with a Silver Feather in recognition for his many good works on behalf of the Bar-



ony since joining less then a year ago.

In addition to the heavy weapons tourney, there was ample space for our fencers.



For those of a non-martial bent, there was dancing, feasting and shopping. The event was crowned with a feast prepared by Suzanne Neuber de Londres and her generous staff

of helpers, Isabeau, Gianetta and Miranda Flame-keeper.
