Needle cases, sets of needles (bone, metal, wood), scissor cases, pin cushions, sewing kits, skeins of handspun yarn, lucets, drop spindles

Feast items, 2 points each:

Plates, mugs, glasses, napkins, candle holders

Cords, 1 point per yard:

Fingerloop braids, kumihimo, lucet cord

Pouches or bags, 2 points each:

Drawstring bags in small/medium/large, belt pouches

Jewelry, 2 points each:

Fibulas, penannular brooches, bracelets, earrings (pair), necklaces, pendants, pewter items, viking wire work, veil pins, paternosters/rosaries, lampwork beads (2 beads), rings

Wooden items, 3 points each:

Small/medium boxes, game boards and pieces, candle holders, wax tablets, small foot stools

Household items, 2 points each:

Soap, beauty/personal care items, candles, period spices and spice mixes, bottle opener, leather mug strap

The Barony will be hosting King and Queens Rattan Champions, on June 21st, in Middle Island. There is lots to be done, starting with set-up on Friday night through clean-up on Sunday morning.

The only staff position that has been filled is Autocrat. That's me, Lord Thorolf Egillsen. I'd like to make all of my staffing decisions by mid-March. To that end, there will be an open meeting March 15th 2:00pm at the Baroness's house, 417 Free State Dr., Shirley, NY 11967. Google it if you need directions. I have some volunteers: for some positions too many, for some none at all. I know everything will come together at the event, but pre-planning never hurts. Given the scope of this event every function of the event will require some orchestration in set-up, execution and clean up..

Some areas that need coordination (but not exclusive):

Battlefield - which will need its own crew - and need to be coordinated with kingdom.

Cooking - as this is a camping event so there will be two breakfasts, a dayboard and and a feast. I'm inclined not to have a single cook, but am looking for a consortium. Anyone who would like to be involved in the cooking should attend the above mentioned meeting; as we will review the available cooking equipment, set the menu and responsibilities. No kitchen volunteer will be turned away.

Troll - the reservations are already being handled by the exchequer - however a pool of staff will be needed to keep check-in running smoothly. As this is a Kingdom event - we do expect a larger crowd trolling in than the Barony might be used to, and would like this to be done fast and efficiently.

Non combative activities - this is open for discussion - all ideas welcome for consideration. This area can include entertainment for during evening feast. Parking - again as there will be a larger crowd than usual parking also need to be efficient.

The Barony is renting the cabins as function space. Staff will be allowed to crash in some of the cabin space Friday and Saturday nights, based on availability. If your going to be there Friday night to help set up, please let me know.
