The History of An Dubhaigeainn

Installment 1

The History of the Shire of An Dubhaigeainn 1982 – 1990 was compiled by Fionnghuala Gliobach Mael Ailbe it was then scanned, edited (A.S. dates corrected) and format cleaned up by Suzanne Neüber de Londres

A brief chronology of the SCA and its Long Island branches: (excerpted from A Geographic History of the East Kingdom by Lord Richard the Poor of Ely

AS I: The Society for Creative Anachronism was born in what has now become the Kingdom of the West (5/1/66)

AS II: The Kingdom of the East began its development in the area first called Two Rivers in AS VI and then named the

Crown Province of Ostgardr in ASX (4/68)

AS X: The Shire of the Brook was founded at SUNY Stony Brook (8/76-12/78)

AS XII: The Shire of Dorno Aral was created in Suffolk County (7/78)

AS XIV: Ostgardr gained the Canton of Walking Dunes at Southampton College (3/80-5/81)

AS XVI: Dorno Aran was supplanted by An Dubhaigeainn (8/82)

AS XXII: Ostgardr's incipient Canton of Lions End was formed in Nassau County; Official status granted ASXXIII: (2/88)

AS XXVI: An Dubhaigeainn petitions for Baronial status, granted by TRM Balfar and Luna; Muirdeach and Mairgret of

Carrigart created Baron and Baroness (11/9/91) on the 10th anniversary of the Shire.

In AS XVI, during the reign of Their Royal Majesties Siegfried and Wanda, King and Queen of the East, the Shire of An Dubhaigeainn was brought into being in the month of August beside the dark waters for which it is named. The An Dubhaigeainn device blazon: Azure, a duck naiant to sinister Argent, billed within a laurel wreath Or.

AUGUST 1982--First issue of the Shire newsletter, with 46 members listed.

OCTOBER 1982--The newsletter first appears under the name VIADUCT on Oct. 21, a demo was held at Selden campus of SCCC.

MINISTER OF SCIENCES: Michal Mor 0' Faolinn

NOVEMBER 1982 - At the Feast of St. Andrew's Eve, observed on Nov. 27th, there was a contest for "Best Duck," which was won by Diana with a Mallard duck meat pie. Her prize was a pewter duck saltcellar. Kieran was awarded "Best Effort" for his demonstration of a "duck", Diana also won a competition for Best Celtic Garb, for which she received a wicker duck basket.

DECEMBER 1982 - VIADUCT'S first article, "The Medieval Feast," by Norman the Norman. Activities on the calendar: Minstrels and Cooks Guilds.

APRIL 1983 - On Apr. 9, a Day of Dance was held on Apr. 30; there was a demo for Cub Scouts.

AS XVII - in the reign of TRM Vissevald and Mara:

MAY 1983 - On May 7, Beltaine was observed; May 28-29, Huntington Ren Faire was held.

JULY 1983 - The newsletter indicates that Cooks Guild was still active; at the previous business meeting an autocrat's award was created, and it was decided that a structure for commons meetings should be planned (further details do not appear in subsequent issues of VIADUCT, however). Also, a Book of Heraldry was to be created, and kept by the Shire Herald.

SHIRE HISTORIAN: Norman the Norman; (deputy) Laura Puchalski

AS XVIII - In the reign of TRM Viktor and Sedalia:

NOVEMBER 1983 - The Feast of St. Andrew's was held on the 26th.

(*missing first issue of VIADUCT from 1984)

AS XVIII - in the reign of TRM Hasdrubal and Amber:

MAY 1984 - 20 members listed, Cooks Guild and Brewers meeting. On May 26-27, Huntington Ren Faire held.

JUNE 1984 - Diana to begin work on the Book of Heraldry, according to VIADUCT. (The Lady has no recall of such a project being commissioned.) Boy Scout demo on the 9th, Southold Ren Faire on the 10th.

JULY 1984 - Diana's design is chosen in the Newsletter cover contest. Cooks and garbing workshops on the calendar.

SEPTEMBER 1984 - Folk active in calligraphy also.

AS XIX - In the reign of TRM Hanno and Kunegunda:

JANUARY 1985 - Calendar shows meetings of Cooks Guild and Dance instructions.

February 1985 (issue missing)

MARCH 1985 - Only Cooks Guild active. Dance instruction was frequently held before business meetings around this time, led by Richard the Poor.

(*possibly no further issues before Vol. 2 No. 1)

AS XIX - in the reign of TRM Morgan and Rowan:

AS XX - in the reign of TRM Siegfried and Wanda:

SEPTEMBER 7, 1985 - Day of Dance held, with Mistress Aravis and Diana teaching in the afternoon. A number of us recall this fondly as our First Event, where we met a very pleasant group of gentles from Dragonship Haven, Ostgardr, and Carillion

In the reign of TRM Siegfried and Wanda:

NOVEMBER 1985 - Business Meeting mediated by Baron of Carillion, Pug Mahon, on the 7th. Feast of St. Andrew on the 30th.

DECEMBER 1985 - (VIADUCT Vol. 2 No.1)

CHRONICLER: Cynyr Longtoes

MINISTER OF SCIENCES: Tomas Mac Seamus an Ceard

HERALD: Bogdan Zelaznagora
