Arrow, Axes and Ales Court Unofficial Report

15 September 2018 AS 53

After a fun filled day, Prefect Titus Aurelius Magnus, and Baroness Sorcha of Stonegrave convened Court at the Estonia House in Middle Island, New York.

M'lord Angel of An Dubhaigeainn was called in to tell the populace of the Archery Tournament he ran. A single elimination tourney, where the target was the image of a Weeping Angel. Contestants needed to hit in the legs, torso, and head (best 2 of 3) before the opponent could do the same. An ingenious design by Lord Ronan FitzRobert made it fun. The winner was m'lord Tommaso Parlapiano. He stepped from behind their Excellencies, as he is the current Fencing Champion, was invested with the Regalia of the Archery Champion and awarded a Scroll by Lady Sláine báen Ronan (calligraphy & illumination) & Lady Miriam Giantslayer (drawings). Tomasso returned to his place behind the Seats, and M'lord Angel was awarded a Glass Duck in honor of his Year of Service as Archery Champion.

Next Lord Magnus Sverre Haakonson DeLondres was requested to let the populace know of the Thrown Weapons Tourney. It was 2 rounds with each weapon, knife, axe, and spear, of 2 throws per round...the targeting was unusually not centered on the target, but rather in a different place on each round. The scoring was based on how close you came to that Marked Spot, in inches, with lowest score winning. There were many participants, but in the end it was m'lord Michael Leg Bane who reclaimed the Ducky Spear, and a Scroll by Lady Violet Hughes (calligraphy), Lady Miriam (drawings), & Lady Sláine (illumination.) Lord Magnus too, was presented a Glass Duck for his tenure as Thrown Weapons Champion.

The Youth of the Society were not to be outdone. M'lord Michael & Lady Fiona begged leave to inform the populace that we held our first Youth Throwing Competition, Save the Duckies. The children each got 2 axes per round and threw for 2 rounds. They had to break the string holding the Duckies, which released them into the Duck Pond. Most Duckies saved won. M'lord Tiberius Trebellius Severus won with 1 Duckies saved. Lady Caoilfhionn inghean Ceallachain got a separate award for having the first axe to stick in the target.

The Brewing Championship was lightly entered, and actually hotly contested. Lady Fiona the Volatile was the only entrant, but there was long and involved discussion as to which of her two entries was the better. At last, the judges decided that the Bochet from "Le Menagier de Paris" was preferred, and Lady Fiona received a scroll by Lady Sláine (calligraphy & illumination) & Lady Miriam (drawings).

The two newest officers of our Beloved Barony each in turn took their Fealty Oaths, M'lord Oswyn Northwode is our new Exchequer, and Lady Sláine our new Herald.

Then their Excellencies did recall that they have been stewarding a Scroll and Regalia for the newest member of the Order of the Silver Wheel residing in our Fine Feathered Domain. The Order was called before their excellencies, and Lord Ronan FitzRobert was called into Their presence to Receive a Scroll by Eadaoin Chiuitire and a Silver Wheel Pendant. The Ducks already among the Wheels rolled on to the back of the assemblage to Welcome him.

The History of An Dubhaigeainn

Installment 2

JANUARY 1986 - 44 members listed, Cooks and Brewers active. On the 6th, Cynyr's birthday, Gunther held a Twelfth Night celebration. Thus was Cynyr chosen as King of Misrule; Diana was then chosen Queen of Misrule, and demanded much foolish entertainment be rendered for Their Majesties' pleasure. Bryghainn was the highlight, for he not only won the Gargoyle contest, but also obeyed the Queen's call to "Bring on the dancing boys!" by improvising a seductive veiled dance with a paper napkin. Having lost at being a gargoyle, Gunther gave his now famous life-like impression of a fountain decoration. Also, we soft-hearted folk allowed a wee small cat to be secreted in the house on that frosty night ... and the rest of them are history.

MARCH 1986 - Archery practices. Some of what folk enjoyed at Celtic Silliness in Ostgardr on the 22nd: "Seeing the wild Picts attacking the Romans and booting them back to Italy" <that was Cynyr),

Lorenzo winning 2nd prize in the Silly Sciences competition with a boffer Duck Pie--"the finest in (silly) assassins' weapons" (Ashruf entered a 3x5 foot card as her "documentation") and watching the Silly Fashion Show--kudos in particular were due the Mayan in Winter ensemble, the Norman Fling gown, the sleeve design of which was gushingly described as centuries ahead of its time," and Gwenlynn's Celtic Kimono.

APRIL 1986 - Armorers workshops added. Apr. 20, First Annual Ren Faire at C.W. Post put on by House von Morgenwind, sponsored by the Crown Province of Ostgardr. The demonstration of falconry was especially interesting; and of singular amusement was the sight of the May Pole--Kieran and Norman--making a mad dash in search of Chinese food, tea, and more precisely, escape from the enthused dancers!

AS XX--in the reign of TRM Ronald and Bronwyn:

JUNE 1987 - On the 13th, the first Islip Americana Fair demo was given. Gunther and Muirdeach opened the fighting demos with short lessons on SCA fighting and armor inspection.
