This good gentle took this opportunity to announce the Palio aspects of the day, which included a scavenger hunt and the aforementioned Hobby Horse Race.

Name: Lisa Soto

SCA name: Vetra trys Kaukoles (which translates to Tempest of Three Skulls). I also have a former name Catrina ab Aqua from when I started in the Society and my official registered name is Lisa of An Dubhaigheainn

How did you learn about the SCA? My good friend Fiona the Volatile invited me to go to Pennsic in 1999 at a picnic for the Stony Brook Science Fiction Forum. The rest is history!

What about it attracted you? Wearing garb, socializing and the general "atmosphere" drew me in instantly. I was utterly enchanted with all the clothes and the personalities! Especially being called, "m'lady" and the pageantry of it all.

How long have you been part of the SCA? 19 years - Pennsic 1999 was my very FIRST event!

What is your SCA persona? I strongly relate to my Lithuanian heritage, so that's where my persona comes from. Lithuania is a small country now, but it was once a Grand Duchy in Europe. I'm most interested in pre-Christian Lithuanian history (before the Crusades) because they were essentially Baltic Vikings. (Viking is a job title, in case you didn't know!) There's very little research on it to date, but it's incredibly interesting to me.

What activities do you participate in? Well, I just stepped up to serve as the Seneschal of the Barony, so I'd say that doing service is where I do most of my participation right now! I've also cooked quite a bit of period accu-

rate food over the past 5 years, both for events and for experimental workshops. Before I was a cook, I fought Heavy List for 8 years and served a year as Knight Marshal. When I first started out, I did a LOT of sewing. I basically reinvent my participation every 5-7 years to keep things fresh and interesting.

What has been your favorite event? I don't really have a favorite of all-time, but I do really LOVE when we have a local Royal Progress event. It gives us such a great opportunity to show off all the talents and accomplishments of our Ducky Populace!

What would you say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far? Most recently, having the food at Feast of St. Andrew's so well received back in November of 2018. We prepared for that dayboard and feast for about a year and did 9+ months of research and workshops to get everything as perfect as we could. I am super proud of the team that came together that made that happen and I'm incredibly honored that I got to lead them.

What future goals do you have in the SCA? I want to be the best Seneschal I can be for the Barony!



The History of An Dubhaigeainn

Installment 5

DECEMBER 1989 – Shire folk participated in a Tree Lighting & Caroling on th 2nd, at the invitation of Islip Town. At Lions in Winter, on the 9th in Lions End, Diana sold Middle Eastern wares, while Nova offered an array of soft furs. A few of us introduced ourselves to Court Baroness Trogrim, an exceedingly pleasant personage whom we had first seen at our Day of Dance; those who enjoy needlework were soon marveling at her beautiful pieces. Nova, Phelan and Michal entered their products in the Brewing completion, and all "won" for lack of other entries in their categories. The feast was delicious and too plentiful for most of us who think we can pace ourselves... Pandemonium played and Cantillation sang – and the whole of An Dubhaigeainn sang, Lions End Seneschal, Lady Reyna a Happy Anniversary (to the William Tell Overture--this plan hatched by Phelan and Teresa), as this was the anniversary of the Canton's first event. Duke Oengus, in a surprise appearance before Baron Ian's Court, praised Lord William Keith Fitz Garanhir, the son of his old friend Baron Sir Garanhir, stating that this young man's example had moved him to exchange old ways for new--thus, he swore fealty to Ian and Ostgardr. Later in the evening, Dance Master Phelan agreed to be loaned to the Lions, and Pandemonium played for the dancers. At the business :meeting on the 18th, John of Graves End was elected Sheriff < proposed responsibilities and restrictions for this new office are to be found in the March A. S. XIV V IADUCT, Vol. 5 #8).

JANUARY 1990 - Some of our folk went down to Marwick on the 13th for East Kingdom Twelfth Night; thus, they had the pleasure of witnessing Their Royal Majesties award Arms to Geoffrey Chamberlain, and induct Muirdeach of Carrigart into the Order of the Tygers Combattant.

FEBRUARY 1990 - On the 24th, at our Tavern Event, period games abounded, to be played for--and bet on with--chocolate "coin", and there were contests of physical prowess. Muirdeach won at push-ups, and Eanraig bested all at arm wrestling. During the feast, which was prepared by Duchess Sedelia, the bardic baton was passed for individual and group singing and tales, and Cantillation also sang its latest pieces.

MARCH 1990 - A Middle Eastern Commons was held on the 24th at Leif's. The experiment by Rosamonde and Timmus of passing out recipes (with consideration of folks' time, cooking ability, and purses) proved very successful, with 26 gentles attending. Rosamonde taught Ukrainian Egg decorating in the afternoon, and the musicians got together and played after dinner. The Seneschal was pleased to announce the upcoming wedding of his sister, Freydis of Lillihjem to Eanraig Leigheasbeagan, whose SCA wedding was planned for Beltane on May 5th.

APRIL 1990 - On the 7th, Lorenzo was called into Court to receive his AOA scroll made by Timmus; it was hinged tablets of wood, with Arabic- style carvings on the back, and Arabic script work on the front. Mary (aka Katie) of Carrigart was made a Companion of the Tyger's Cub; and her mother, Mairgret, reports that the Crowns were given and received with honor and grace at the Last Court of Their Royal Majesties Horic and Lea in Their Barony of Settmour Swamp. On the 14th, Commons was held. C. W. Post Ren Fair was held on the 22nd in Lions End; only a handful of shire folk went, due to mundane considerations, which disappointed Richard the

Poor and his Northpass friends who had expected to see us, and the Lions Enders Lorenzo and Timmus went and fought in the demo, and Henri and Phelan were there, too. Some folks got up to Bizarre Bazarre III in Dragonship Haven on the 28th, and enjoyed themselves.
