How did you learn about the SCA?

APRIL 1996 - Suffolk County Fair 4/27-28 and 5/4-5

Lyrics to the Moose song Published In the VIADUCT

MAY 1996

5/17-19 - Whitsun Beltane Baronial War Practice & Camping event was held Riverhead (auto-crated by Lilith & Thorolf). - The Viking burned down the cottages and the Celts attacked the Vikings. Goths attacked the Celts and the Huns watched, laughed and killed the rest. Then they rested and the English killed them all. All in all the event went over well and the food was great and plentiful. The incipient canton on Lin de Gealach took care of breakfast Saturday and Stormhaven on Sunday, Lay Lilith took care of lunch and Lady Bree took care of Dinner.

JUNE 1996 - 6/8 - Islip American Fair - demo

JULY 1996

A banner making workshop was held on the 12th to aid in the décor for the St Andrew's event.

AS XXIV - in the reign of TRM Ronald and Bronwyn:

MAY 1990 - Beltane, on the 5th, was special for two reasons-- it took place in a great old (almost period!) site, and it featured the hand-fasting of Eanraig and Freydis, complete with Maypole, Bribing of Relatives (i.e., Leif), and the Celtic-style wedding rite presided over by Steven, Eanraig's brother. The fine feast was created by Gunther and Gwenlynn, and to honor the bride and groom, there was music by Pandemonium, song by Cantillation, and belly dancing by Lady Diana, who returns to us often from her new home afar. Also, the "Ancient Order of Banner Hangers, Pennon Danglers and Standard Suspenders," aka Phelan and Geoffrey, was formed--the hall looked really great! A questionnaire was published in VIADUCT to gather ideas and opinions on becoming a Barony. Once again, out with greater success, a Domesday/Contact List questionnaire was passed out, this time by Rosamonde and Geoffrey. On the 26th and 27th, Huntington Ren Fair took place in Ostgardr.

AS XXVI - in the reign of TRM Balfar and Luna:

NOVEMBER 9, 1991 - The Shire of An Dubhaigeainn becomes the Barony An Dubhaigeainn; investing their first coronets, Sir Muirdeach of Carrigart and Lady Mairgret of Carrigart at the Feast of St Andrew.
