Unofficial Court Report: Pennsic

In the sunny early evening of Pennsic, as the populace gathered under the common tent, the court of Prefect Titus and Baroness Sorcha opened.

Their excellencies called forth Jean Xavier Boullier. They discussed all the awards and accolades he has and wondered if there was anything else they could present him with. Then they came to the conclusion that he is often seen on the martial field, as well as demonstrating the art of pewter casting, and also he is often found doing work behind the scenes. SEPTEMBER 1998

At ICON on the 1st, our chatelaine yielded 21 interested people from the County Fair Demo and 40 from the ICON Demo - the barony may be growing soon.

MAY 2000

The Crown Tournament of Their Majesties Balfar and Luna took place in May 13th in the Barony Beyond the Mountain. The winner was Sir Andreas Icefalcon, whose consort was our very own Mistress Isabella of York. This is the fifth time that Andreas reached the finals with Isabella at his side.

Isabella said that you never win crown when you are ready. Which proved to be the case this go around. Having lost five of her loved ones in the past six months, she had not attended an event in four months, despite being a kingdom-level player for 16 years. When Andreas called to ask that he be allowed to fight for her, she at first declined. Both Andreas and Isabella were slightly out of character that day, Andreas being unshaven and Isabella in mis-matched ruffs.

Also at Crown Tournament, Mistress Suzanne hosted a Laurel vigil for her brother Baron Sean de Londres at crown as well. And Baroness Mairgret of Carrigart was given a Queens Order of Courtesy.

Members of the barony participated in the Suffolk County Fair on 5/6, 7, 13 & 14, at the Suffolk Meadows Race Track. On the weekend of May 20 & 21 the Grievance day at the Village event in the canton of Sandmork has been postponed to next year due to site issues.

Member Highlight

Name: Lord Fearghus mac Cailin mka Brian Carroll

How did you learn about the SCA?

My friend of many years became involved with it, and she invited us to Pennsic. We went in 2007 and had a fantastic time. Following that, we began to focus on having a family, so we did not return until 2013, where we camped with that same friend and still do to this day.

What about it attracted you?

Initially, it felt like the best parts of camping and Ren Faires melded together. The deeper I delved into it, however, I found that much of the society resonated with the core beliefs I have with regard to honor, virtue, and the like. It wasn't long before I could plainly see that the SCA was a place where I would be at home. A place where I could be closer to the person that, deep down, I've always wanted to be.

How long have you been a part of the SCA?

I believe I became a member of the society in 2013, and have maintained membership since then.

What is your SCA persona ?

My persona is late 16th century Scottish, from the highlands that speak Gaelic, mainly so I can wear a kilt and have it be somewhat period.

What activities do you participate in?

At present, I'm a heavy list fighter, I do thrown weapons, I'm a member of the East Kingdom Royal Assassin's Guild (an A&S group), and plan to learn fencing sometime during the next year or so.

What has been your favorite event?

My favorite event is still Pennsic. I love camping with my friends, having fun, and being able to fight in large melees and singles tournies alike. I also enjoy meeting new people from all over the known world, and having a few drinks and laughs with them!

What has been your favorite moment?

Thus far, my favorite moment would have to be when Mistress Sofya Gianetta di Trieste was elevated. I was attending their majesties during court, and had been present during the morning when she became apprentice to a new peer (her previous peer passed away suddenly). She was elevated to the Order of the Maunche that court, and was so overjoyed and overwhelmed to have been so. Then, she was told by their majesties that this simply wasn't enough, and the Order of the Laurel was called. Seeing that moment, and having felt the emotions involved, still chokes me up when I think about it.

What would say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far?

I have received my AoA, a Silver Feather, a Drake's Spur, I am a member of the Order of the Silver Tyger, I am an initiate in the East Kingdom Royal Assassin's Guild, I am a member of the Running with Scissors sprint team at Pennsic, and am the only member of the Order of the Blade of Grass. I have also run the East Kingdom's team for the Atlantian 10 man melee tournament at Pennsic the past 2 years, and the East Kingdom's Royal Assassin's team at Pennsic the past 5 years, bringing the East victory in the latter 2/3 times (other years nobody won). My favorite of these is my Silver Tyger, as it was not planned or written in, but given by Duke Brennan (who created the order) on the battlefield for my actions that day. I am also acting Seneschal of the Barony of An Dubhaigeainn.

What future goals do you have in the SCA? My goals are rather simple, I plan to delve deeper into the society, learn more, teach more, have more fun, and hopefully spread my love of the SCA to those around me.
