Name: Akos Zekel

How did you learn about the SCA?

Through a friend who wanted to do a more serious LARP - he knew someone in Surtr's Brood, which led to the broader community.

What about it attracted you?

At the start it was getting to socialize with people who were smart, interesting, and easy to talk to. As it went I also gained an appreciation and admiration for the skills involved in the A&S community as well.

How long have you been a part of the SCA?

Time and I don't get along at the best of times, but I think it's been... wow, three years already.

What is your SCA persona?

I'm a traveling Franciscan monk, formerly of a noble Hungarian family in the 1400's that got into trouble for wanting to learn too much about

"peasant" skills instead of participating in the hosting that was common at the time. Ask me about the time I was "captured" by some Norsemen.

What activities do you participate in?

I tried spear fighting for a bit, and while I was tolerably good I also hated it. These days I brew, sew, do some whittling, do target archery, cooking (so much cooking), and a few other random A&S activities.

What has been your favorite event?

Well, I think my first Pennsic stuck in my mind most firmly, but I've also loved Ghosts, Ghouls, and Goblins.

What has been your favorite moment?

Oh goodness, just one? I can narrow it to a category: seeing good people I know get awards for their efforts. I go hoarse from the shouting in support.

What would say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far?

Accomplishments? I've made wines people who hated wines liked, and wines that purists liked the taste of. I got a pretty AoA one time. I made a walking stick in pure period style. I've gotten many fighters registered and helped keep events sane and safe (mostly the marshals do that last part). I was Feastocrat for two event-spanning day boards (note: when quadrupling the recipe for pretzel dough, *don't* quadruple the yeast). I hit a knight in the faceplate with a spear once. Oh, and most importantly I've been there when people needed someone to reach out to them.

What future goals do you have in the SCA?

I think I'd like to step back a little and relax and enjoy myself a little more, get back into the original reason I started.

OCTOBER 2001

NOVEMEBR 2001

St Andrew Sails to the New World which was staged at St Peters by the Sea on 11/24, produced two new Baronial champions, Lady Kaleigh for Archery and Lady Lassar for Heavy list. Let' hear it for the Girls!! Lord Alexander MacLaughlin put together a great staff and the Brothers Grimm (Ori & Franceso) put out a great feast. The Baronial polling has not been resolved - the investiture has been move to Carnival Time in January.

DECEMBER 2001
