Crowns A&S Champions, 2021

December 13th, 2020 - January 31st, 2021

Event details

Due to COVID-19 the 2021 Crown's A&S Championships will be held virtually over the month of January 2021!

While running this online will present some challenges, it also creates many opportunities with more time to view entries, discuss with entrants, and participate, and our staff will be assisting every step of the way to ensure broad access. *Advanced registration* is required. Please see below for details.

The online event will provide a web page to host entries by each entrant, both for competitors and displayers, similar to our online A&S displays we have hosted. Members of the populace are encouraged to leave comments as tokens and will be able to view the pages and connect with the artisans.

Additionally, we will assist artisans who are interested in recording short presentations on their topic to share their voice and knowledge in multiple formats for all to view. Judging will be done in two rounds via videocalls (accommodations can be made for those needing alternative technology) during the last two weeks in January.

Those considering entering are advised that this is a high-level competition where the focus is on picking the kingdom arts and sciences champions. The judging is rigorous, and entrants are expected to be familiar with the kingdom A&S rubric, which will be used to assess entries. The duties of the champions include representing the Crown at events, participating in the Pennsic A&S War Point, and assisting the MoAS office in running next year's Crown's A&S.

*First round of Judging and entrant display on MoAS Website - January 17th-23rd

Name: Lady Ealusaid inghean ui MacPhaidin mka Lisa Seckler-Roode

How did you learn about the SCA?

I've had a LIFELONG fascination with the Middle Ages, (probably as a result of falling in love with the film "The Adventures of Robin Hood" with Erroll Flynn and Olivia de Havilland, when I was 4! I was a regular attendee at the NY Renaissance Faire in Tuxedo from the very beginning, as well as being involved with a number of British folk bands as Tour Manager, and Publicist. In my early twenties I was lucky enough to live in the UK for some months working on a film, and fell head over heels in love with their historic sites, people, and vibe. 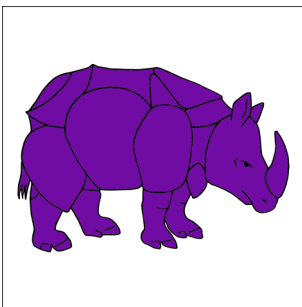

The History of An Dubhaigeainn

Installment 24

MAY 2006

A Newcomers common was held on 5/6 at the home of Mary Fernandez in East Moriches. BBQ, Bonfire, Fighting, Fencing, and a fine medieval time was had by all.

Avalon Gardens, a local nursing and rehabilitation center, held a medieval themed event on the 18th in which a dozen or so gentles of the Barony added some 'drama' to the event. Someone had the 'nerve' to step on the Baronesses foot... a gauntlet was thrown and a dual ensued. After calling a truce we danced.

A Letter of intent for the Baronial seat from Master Ateno & Lady Lassar was published in the Viaduct.

JUNE 2006

AUGUST 2006

At Pennsic the Barony hosted "Runnymede Dinner" and was a smashing success. Lord Thorolf and Baroness Mistress Suzanne Neüber de Londres and the rest of the Vincog encampment opened their spacious camp for the dinner and providing shelter to the entertainers.
