Day of Martial Champions

As plague begins to retreat from our lands the time has come for us to carefully gather together again! In Settmour Swamp we have business to attend to – for it is long overdue that we find our recently installed Baron and Baroness, new martial champions.

Details to follow on how exactly we will be going about it, but there will be competition to find champions of Heavy List, Fencing, Thrown Weapons and Archery, and there may be Youth Combat as well (checking on guidelines -will advise)

We will be following all SCA, CDC and NJ state guidelines in place at the time of the event. The most recent SCA guidelines are here: https://www.eastkingdom.org/ek_announcement/. Masking when in close proximity to others is encouraged. Bathroom facilities and shared surfaces including the check-in table and MOL table will be wiped down regularly and masks, sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be readily available. This is a fairly rustic site, and therefore we encourage attendees to change at their vehicles or arrive in garb.

Crown Tournament of Magnus Tindal and Alberic von Rostock

July 17th Shire of Hartshorn-dale - Collegeville, PA

We welcome you to join the Shire of Harthsorn-dale and the Barony of Bhakail as we host the Royal Consuls, Tindal and Alberic, so that they can hold their crown tournament to find their heirs to the Eastern Thrones.

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

- 1.Registration will be pre-registered and pre-paid only. Gate will be no touch, with Gate staff checking off attendees as they arrive.
- 2. Attendees should be aware that event staff will be monitoring that masks are worn fully covering the mouth and nose. We will remind you to adjust mask wearing to keep the mouth and nose covered.
- 4. There will be picnic tables set aside as the designated area to eat and drink. Food and drink may not be shared. While eating and drinking you must remain stationary and socially distanced, and replace your mask when leaving the table.
- 5. The event will be entirely outdoors except for the restrooms. Event staff will be monitoring this area to prevent loitering.
- 6. High touch surfaces, such as door handles leading to the bathrooms, faucets, and any high touch surface outdoors, will be wiped down every two hours.
- 7. Purell hand sanitizer is available throughout the site.
- 8. Outdoor changing rooms will be provided, but attendees will be encouraged to arrive in garb if possible. Family groups will be allowed to use a changing room together. The rooms will then be left unoccupied for 5 minutes between groups in order for any airborne particles to settle/blow away before the next group.
- 9. We will continue to monitor local and state rules, as well as SCA guidance on Covid restrictions.
- 10. Individually packaged water bottles are available.

Activities will be limited to combat between combatants vying for the thrones of the East Kingdom, followed by the court of their majesties. No other activities are planned.

The large pavilion offers plenty of shaded area available so we ask that you do not bring personal day shades, unless cleared with the autocrats. We ask that attendees keep their set up to the minimum, bringing chairs and food & drink as needed for yourself.

Attendees are encouraged to arrive in garb but if needed there will be outdoor changing areas available. There will be individually bottled water, but attendees should bring food and drink as needed. Site restrictions: NO alcohol and NO smoking, including vaping.

Pre-registration is absolutely required, please pay attention to the deadlines to get registration in. The event is being capped at 150 attendees to maintain the safety plan.

Many people did different things during the day and the rain held off until court that afternoon. Speaking of court, two things of interest for An Dubhaigeainn: Our own Baron Jean Xavier was given the Highest available East Kingdom award for fencing called the Order of the Golden Rapier, and your Baroness and mine, Lassar Ingen Aeda, was the overall winner of the Heavy List, which included fighting, test on knightly knowledge and actions throughout the tournament sponsored by Viscount Sir Edward. The feast came out on time and the rain let up enough that the road home was much easier than it could have been.

Talk about an event packed with activities! Over twenty entries were received for the brewery contest and there were archery and fencing tournaments, as well as heavy list sparring, merchants, tastings and a pub sing. Whew! For the Rapier fighters there were the Dueling and progressive weapons Tournaments, both won by our Ostgardr neighbor, Sayyid Ibrahim al Rashid. There was also a Tavern Tourney won by Maeve of Aberdeen from Lion's End. The Archers turned out in force for the Petrus the Sylvan Memorial Shoot. Not only did Peter of Hawkwoods win the title of our Baronial Archery Champion, he also got an arrow right into the eye of our unfortunate target boar. Special thanks go to the marshals for all the combat activities. The brewery contest was a huge success. With twenty-three entries running the gamut from cordials to ales, Baron Ateno, along with Sean deLondres, lent their experienced palates to judging the various submissions the populace was also invited to sample the wares and cast their own votes for favorites. In the end, Damiana de Londres won both the non-alcoholic and populous choice categories with her Pomegranate entry, while Fiona the Volatile won the overall competition with her hopped mead entry. When all were sated with the sumptuous feast prepared by Feastocrat Stefan de Londres and his talented team, we were treated to a Period Pub Song contest presided over by our panel of commentators: Baroness Lassar, Dankwert of Surtr's Brood and Dave, the new guy, affectionately christened, 'Davus Novus'.
