Member Highlight





Name: Gilbert Christian Blackmoore AKA Gilchrist Blackmoore mka Jason C Peck

How did you learn about the SCA? My brother James (Sir Richard Fitz Richard Blackmoore) had been part of the SCA and another group for a few years but at the time I had my own things going on in life. Then when I was 19 years old I got into a bad car accident where I broke my pelvis in multiple places, had screws and a plate put in hip to put it all back together and didn't walk, at least without crutches, for six months. When I could finally walk again with just a cane my brother dragged me out to a local medieval event and I was immediately hooked. Within a few months I was playing in SCA proper.

What about it attracted you? This may not be entirely politically correct to say these days but what got me in was the three W's, Women, Wine (mead) and War! SCA speak for sex, drugs and rock-n-roll. But what kept me in was the friendships that I quickly made. I had never felt so completely accepted in my life up to that point. And in thinking about it, that is still true to this day. For whatever reason the medieval societies are chock full of people that go out of their way to welcome and befriend new people. It is our strength.

How long have I been part of the SCA? As I said above, my very first event was a local medieval event in what I want to say was June/July of 1989. Shortly thereafter in the fall I attended my first SCA event. Memory fails me as to the specific event. To my eternal regret, outside influences took me away from society around 1994/1995 and I didn't return until the summer of 2019. I have been trying to make up for lost time ever since.

What is your SCA persona? I am an Anglo-Saxon born around 1250 in a small village near York in the borderlands between Mercia and Northumbria. WIth a thirst for adventure and a wish to escape Norman rule I traveled Southeast and joined the Varangian Guard of the Byzantine Empire. Not satisfied with the lowly state of the guard by that time I returned to England where I then joined Longshanks for the ninth crusade. These days older, and hopefully wiser, my sword is still ready but not used recklessly as in my misspent youth.

What activities do you participate in? I fight heavy as often as I can but I also throw axes, knives and especially spears when given the chance. And it's only a matter of time before I dabble in rapier. I sew my own garb. I make my own armor, shields and rattan weapons. I built my own thrown weapons targets and my spear. In my younger days I also danced. I entered my first bardic competition this year and will hopefully submit my first A&S project by year's end that will be a CA crossbow if I can ever get around to constructing the pile of supplies sitting in my basement. In the future I have plans in my head to build many more things both martial and non-martial. For example, the idea of flying a giant medieval kite at Pennsic intrigues me to no end.

What has been your favorite event? This is like asking someone who your favorite child is. There is no one answer. The massive presence of Pennsic is breathtaking and a must-attend but the brutal endurance contest that is the Birka bearpit is something I long for too. And then I have the 100 Minutes War which is where I truly found my home again in Society with the household in which I now belong (Surtr's Brood). But in reality every event where I am with my chosen family is my favorite event.

Member Highlight cont'd

What has been your favorite moment? Making my first suit of armor with my brother. We spent hours upon hours in Sir Jehan's basement designing and crafting that first suit. I didn't put much stock in it at the time, I was only 19 years old, but it is now a memory that I will never forget.

What would say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far? Two bronze ducks? Lol. I don't have any awards or titles but I have won two thrown weapons events so far, first EK Novice day in 2019 and more recently Settmour Swamps Baronial Championships in 2021 (I declined the honor of being the baronial champion because it's not my barony). But I would say my greatest accomplishment has been fighting through my fears and self-doubt to return to the dream at age 49, after having taken leave for roughly 25 years. This is not something I could have done without the help of Count Nico (MSR), Sir Conrad (MSR), Baron Dankwert Bathory (Danx), the members of Surtr's Brood and the Barony of An Dubhaigeainn, and especially my daughter. Her help and support has been invaluable.

What future goals do you have in the SCA? To live up to the Blackmoore name that my brother bore. I want to be a positive influence to others and helpful where help is needed. If I accomplish those things then I have succeeded. A little bit more selfishly, I want to see my brother's OTC medal worn by an active member again, whether by myself, which I'm working towards, or at least by someone close to me if I never reach that pinnacle.

This event will be held entirely outdoors, rain or shine, other than use of indoor restrooms. We will have plenty of hand sanitizer throughout the event and we will be cleaning high-touch areas frequently. Please bring your own chairs, if possible.

Per Their Majesties request, we require all attendees to wear a face covering over their mouth and nose to safeguard the most vulnerable among us and for the comfort of attendees.

Due to loosening of restrictions from Society and Kingdom, we are now able to offer a light dayboard at the upcoming Arrows, Axes, and Ales event, being held October 23, 2021. There is no change to the event fees for this addition.

Marcus tracked his step by step progress for each of his projects as well noting all his historical research and sources.
