# Member Highlight

**Name:** Michel Biornson of the Isles mka David Iacona

**How did you learn about the SCA?** I learned about the SCA through friends who introduced me to it.

**What about it attracted you?** I have always been interested in history and its preservation with a healthy dose of loving high fantasy mixed in. The multiple eras that the SCA recreates have always captured my interest between great works of art and architecture and the progress made through invention after invention that we still benefit from today. Being able to become part of a living history of sorts really captured me and motivated me to join.

**How long have I been part of the SCA?** I consider 2016 to be the year that I fully joined. I had been to some smaller events and household commons prior, but 2016 I participated in my first realm wide event at Pennsic.

**What is your SCA persona?** 10th Century Swedish, Viking

**What activities do you participate in?** I have not completely focused on any one activity in the SCA as of yet. Being the perpetual student, I float from activity to activity wanting to learn as much as I can. I find myself dabbling in leatherwork, scribal arts, heavy list fighting, armoring, and carpentry the most.

**What has been your favorite event?** Of the events I've attended, my favorite has been attending the most recent Coronation of the East Kingdom, the Coronation of Ioannes and Honig. It was one of my first experiences traveling to an event outside of An Dubhaigainn and second event that I got to enjoy a royal court.

The theme was Icelandic and everything from the decorations, the classes, and the food was steeped in Icelandic history. His Royal Majesty Konrad von Ulm was in attendance along with several members of his court. Baron Don Jean Xavier did a phenomenal job as autocrat, finding us a beautiful new site at the Masury Estate in Center Moriches. Located right on the water, the site had plenty of room for fighting, merchanting and socializing, as well as a regal hall for feasting. Lady Daria's recent travels to Iceland inspired the theme, and she was on hand to teach several classes in Icelandic culture and literature. An interesting tidbit: the Icelandic language remains virtually intact from medieval times, which means that even today's young Icelandic children are able to read the sagas in their native tongue. A delectable feast was provided by Master Adamantius and his talented kitchen staff who outdid themselves with succulent roasts and period breads soups and side dishes. While there were martial activities, mundane obligations kept our current Baronial Heavy List Champion, Lord Marcus, from attending so their Excellencies did not name their new champion. We look forward to that contest on another date. There were several presentations and awards during both the Baronial and Kingdom courts. Their Excellencies awarded a Silver feather to Lord Logan de Londres, Lord Wilhelm, and Lady Daria of An Dubhaigeainn. Baron Don Jean Xavier was awarded the Drake's Spur. Afterwards, a presentation was made to their Excellencies by Baron Don Jean Xavier, Baroness Gianetta Lucia Alegretta, Lady Daria of An Dubhaigeainn, Lord Peter of Hawkwoods, Lord Peter Bog, Lord Nicodemus the Grey and Lady Elishiva. And what a presentation it was! A hand carved replica of the Valþjófsstaður Door made by Lord Peter and based on research provided by Lady Daria and Lord Marcus who sent over 400 pictures of the original door from Iceland. His Majesty was so impressed with the workmanship that he immediately honored the craftsman by naming him The Honorable Lord Peter of Hawkwoods. Additionally, Miquel d'Avinhon and yours truly received an Award of Arms; as was David Vazques de Valencia. Lord Ulrich, previously honored, was presented by His Majesty with his scroll painted by our own Baroness Lassar. As a final highlight to a wonderful event, His Majesty decreed that The Princess Bride is period.
