





MEMBER HIGHLIGHT

DEMETRIO ANTELINI DA LUCCA

Mundane Name: Cameron Peterson

How did you learn about the SCA? Some friends from SCA adjacent circles were getting involved in the Society and introduced me to it.

What about it attracted you? Initially it was another activity to share with friends, primarily a vacation during the summer to Pennsic. Long term I was attracted to the friendships and community that my involvement provided.



How long have you been part of the SCA? All told about 10 years, though I had a period of Inactivity in the middle.

What is your SCA persona (if you have one)? Late period Italian.

What activities do you participate in (i.e. fencing, A&S, etc.)? Fencing and Heraldry mostly, I'm starting to dabble in A&S as well.

What has been your favorite event? Probably 100 Minutes War. It was my first non-pennsic event, and where I officially joined my fencing household.

What has been your favorite moment? Probably the aforementioned joining the Handsome Boys at 100 Minutes War.

What would you say are your greatest accomplishments in the SCA thus far (a bit of bragging here please, and please list any honors/awards)?
