#### JANUARY 2012

1/8 - Yule Commons - Huntington, NY- Miquel d'Avinhon and Alissenda la Gailharda

The five people running for Coronet recently attended the Yule Baronial Commons where we had an extensive question and answer session. Questions posed covered a wide range of topics including how the candidates view the job, how they intend to interact with our metropolitan neighbors and the East Kingdom, how they would handle any conflict that might arise, and how they would increase membership and participation. All five made clear their intention to serve the full five-year term and represent the Barony at Kingdom level events. While mundane concerns of salary and vacation time constrain everyone's travel time, each of the candidates pointed to their past participation as a good indicator of their willingness to regularly represent An Dubhaigeainn within the larger SCA community. They all would like to foster a spirit of cooperation and energy within the Barony so that we can put our strengths forward and deal with any controversy in a calm and effective manner. A few questions did manage to illuminate some of the subtle differences between the candidates and we've provided highlights as well as contact information for each of the candidates below. Please see last month's Viaduct for more information. We hope to welcome them back for the Winter Canton Commons on February 19th. They'd be happy to hear from you if you have any questions or thoughts.

Weasel's watchwords are Strong and Just. A longtime member of both the Barony and House Three Skulls, Weasel hopes to inspire people to be their best. As he likes to say, he hopes to "utilize people, not use them." He's been in the SCA for over 21 years and believes that by encouraging close ties between new and old, it will help to open up discussions with original energy and ideas. He sees training new recruits as an important part of a baron's job, and hopes to strengthen ties among the various households by "fostering fighting team relationships". He believes a Baron must remain neutral when conflict arises, first ascertaining whether it's a real conflict or just a miscommunication. He might even employ an independent mediator to facilitate solutions. While he is running alone, he feels up to the challenge.

If selected, Logan and Damianna would like to be remembered as Fair but Firm. They would focus on increasing membership and participation by supporting events & activities that appeal to different interests and hope to "open up more doors". Logan has been in the SCA for 22 years, and a member of the barony for ten of those years. Damianna has been playing for slightly less, but each of them stresses their shared experience wearing several managerial hats, whether for their mundane jobs or as former officers of the Barony. To avoid a perception of favoritism, they favor open communication and might employ a neutral party to facilitate discussion. Should problems arise between the EK and the Barony, they favor face to face meetings with officers and royalty informally outside of the SCA to resolve conflict.

## **Baronial History Continued**

Seeking a term that is Open-minded and Effective, Dave and Susan bring over 30 years combined experience in leadership positions in both the SCA and other volunteer organizations. They intend to build on the success of previous Coronets by continuing to foster cooperation amongst the various interests and households in the Barony while maintain a strong presence within the East Kingdom so that the populace will get the support and recognition they deserve. By drawing on their organizational skills and existing relationships (Dave is a member of House Three Skulls, while Susan has long been active in the peerage of the East Kingdom), they hope to minimize potential conflicts through clear communication. Listening and clarifying are key. They plan to work closely with the Seneschal, following Kingdom law, while energizing the populace with a hands-on open-door policy.

Along with a dozen members of the Barony, we happily attended the East Kingdom's 12th Night event in Carillion, where we were honored to witness Lady Sorcha of Stonegrave's induction into the Order of the Silver Crescent. This is a welcome and well-deserved award for service in the East Kingdom. Continuing a tradition, Baroness Lassar gave Lady Sorcha her medallion of the Order, which was once owned by Lord Petrus the Sylvan


