

The theme for our Bardic Competition from Dame Hugoline the Delicate, current Bardic Champ (and Baroness!):

In keeping with this year's theme "Schola at the University: DuckVinci" and the location at Stony Brook University, this year's challenge for the Bardic Championship is a lesson learned. Any type of performance is welcome, song, story, recitation of a poem, dance, magic trick, all performances are welcome. All performances should be period, or SCA appropriate.
