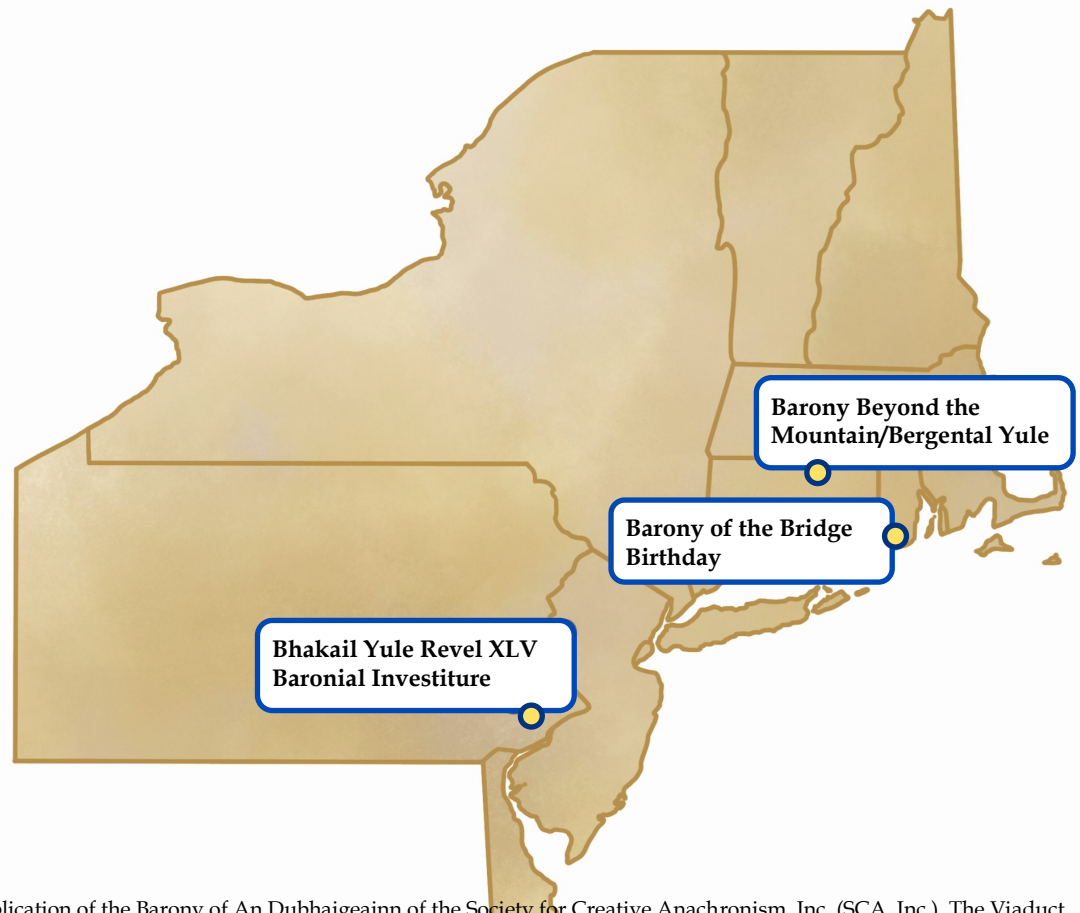

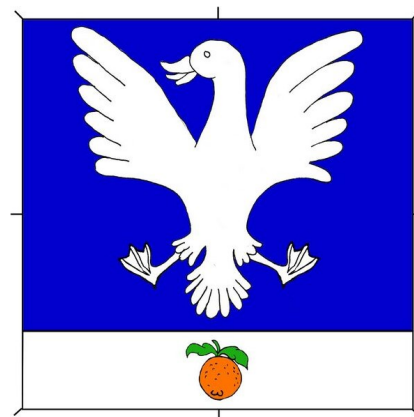

An Dubhaigeainn Cooks' Guild

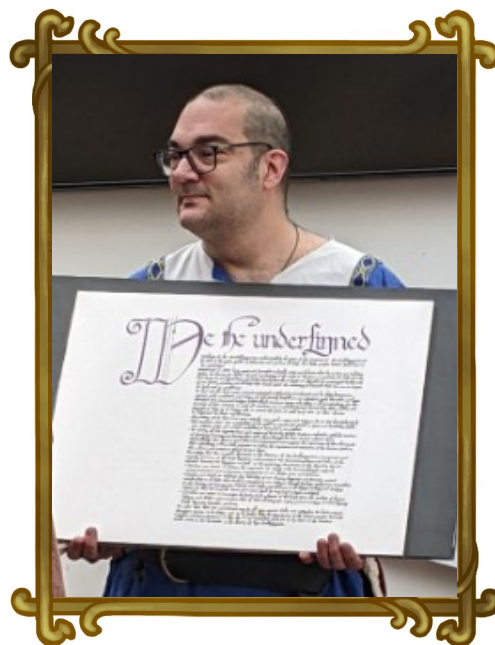


Starting in March 2024, the various interested cooks, servers, brewers, bakers and assorted culinarians of the Barony An Dubhaigeainn came
