# From the Coronet

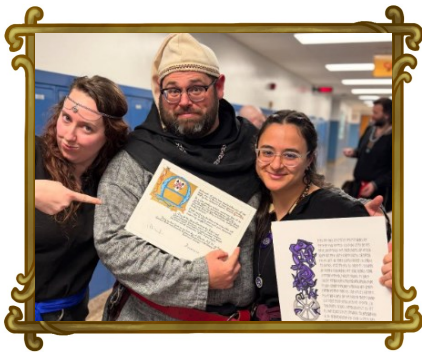


## *Greetings from Your Coronet!*

Michel Biornsen demonstrated his workmanship by displaying two meticulously researched wooden boxes. Fearghus went deep into several rabbit holes in his research on variants of the game of 20 squares, the royal game of Ur and Aseb. This project was so well researched that Fearghus made it to the finals. In court, he was awarded a Golden Lyre for his work.



Several of our Ducks received awards at A&S championships. Osanna Schade, Alverik Wynterveldt, and Bjorn Gardsson all received Awards of Arms. Vigdis Elder was inducted into the Order of the Silver Wheel, and Michel Biornsen was inducted into the order of the Silver Brooch.
